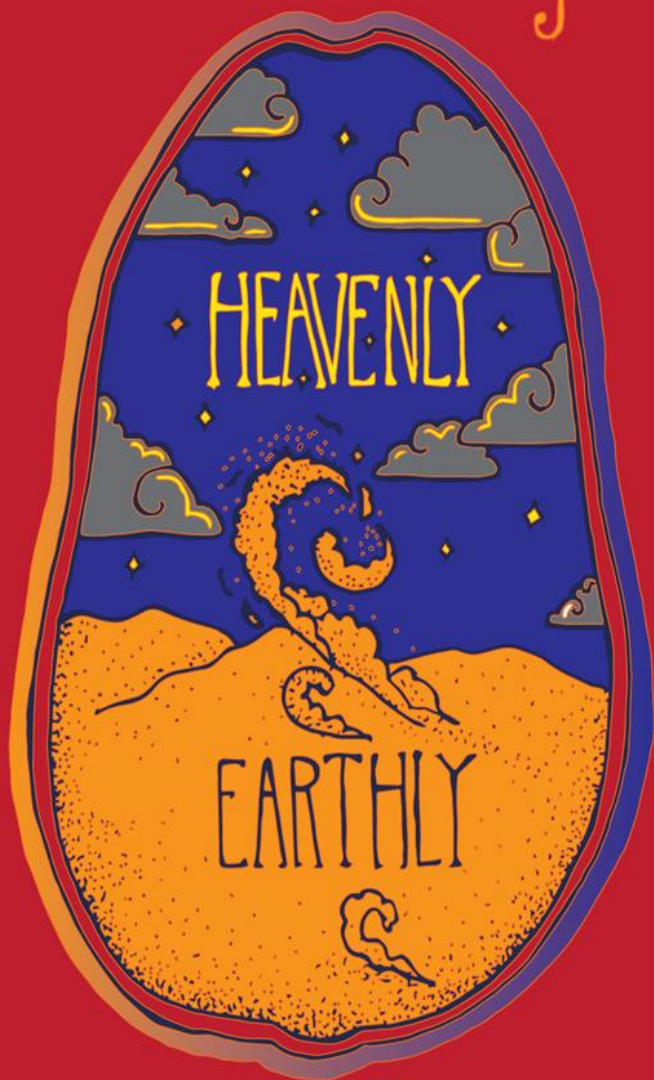


Which seed are you?

“As the deer pants for the water brooks, So my soul pants for You, O God. My soul thirsts for God, for the living God; When shall I come and appear before God?” Psalm 42:1-2 (NASB®)

As a man or woman of God if this verse seems to be your heartbeat in your relationship with God, then you must have a revelation that even though you have “asked Jesus to come into your heart” you know deep down there is something more available. This cannot be the extent of what it means to be a believer and a receiver of Jesus Christ our Master. No matter where you are on your journey you KNOW there must be more for there are still realms that He has called you to walk in that you have not even drank of, but you thirst for. Glory! Friend, if this is you, then keep reading for you are in for some great revelations as you receive the truths presented in this teaching through His precious Word!

Here in Genesis, we see the very first promise God gave to Abram regarding his seed. *“And I will make you a great nation, And I will bless you, And make your name great; And so you shall be a blessing; And I will bless those who bless you, And the one who curses you I will curse. And in you all the families of the earth will be blessed.”* So Abram went forth as the LORD had spoken to him; and Lot went with him. Now Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran.” Genesis 12:2-4 (NASB®)

Then, in the next chapter we see the second promise that God made to Abram regarding his seed. *“The LORD said to Abram, after Lot had separated from him, “Now lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are, northward and southward and eastward and westward; for all the land which you see, I will give it to you and to your descendants forever. I will make your descendants as the dust of the earth, so that if anyone can number the dust of the earth, then your descendants can also be numbered.”* Genesis 13:14-16 (NASB®) You see earthly seed (i.e., the dust of the earth) is connected to natural blessings. **God said “ALL THE LAND WHICH YOU SEE...”**

Now before we move further it is critical to remind ourselves that Abraham was raised in idolatry. The proof is recorded in this passage. *“Joshua said to all the people, “Thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, ‘From ancient times your fathers lived beyond the River, namely, Terah, the father of Abraham and the father of Nahor, and they served other gods.” Joshua 24:2 (NASB®)*

God was doing something new in Abraham after His father Terah died, but until then he only knew a life of idolatry, and oftentimes idolatry was based on what one could see, as in an image. We will see how Abraham gave up idolatry to serve the Living God, but unfortunately these idols were still lingering after Terah for we find them in Laban’s family which was Terah’s great-grandson. (Genesis 31:19, 30 & 32) Please stay with me as I lay this foundation.

Now, after the second blessing of “all that you can see” to the dust of the earth something powerful happens! Abram has a spiritual encounter with a man named Melchizedek in Genesis 14:18-20. However, before we go into that, let’s look at this Melchizedek in order that we may understand the source, and significance of this awesome blessing!

In Hebrews 7 we read, *“For this Melchizedek, king of Salem, priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham as he was returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, to whom also Abraham apportioned a tenth part of all the spoils, was first of all, by the translation of his name, king of righteousness, and then also king of Salem, which is king of peace. Without father, without mother, without genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but made like the Son of God, he remains a priest perpetually. Now observe how great this man was to whom Abraham, the patriarch, gave a tenth of the choicest spoils. And those indeed of the sons of Levi who receive the priest’s office have commandment in the Law to collect a tenth from the people, that is, from their brethren, although these are descended from Abraham. But the one whose genealogy is not traced from them collected a tenth from Abraham and blessed the one who had*

the promises. But without any dispute the lesser is blessed by the greater. In this case mortal men receive tithes, but in that case one receives them, of whom it is witnessed that he lives on. Hebrews 7:1-8 (NASB®)

WE SEE HERE THAT MELCHIZEDEK WAS A KING OF RIGHTEOUSNESS AND PEACE, MADE LIKE UNTO THE SON OF MAN, WITHOUT GENEALOGY, AND HE WAS IMMORTAL! WITHOUT A DOUBT HE OBVIOUSLY WAS A SPIRITUAL MAN, AND ABRAHAM GAVE TO HIM.

So, what was Abraham doing when he gave an offering to him? Instead of sowing to his flesh, he was sowing to the Spirit. In this case Abraham gave a tenth of what he had. (Gen 14:18-20) “For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.” Galatians 6:8 (NASB®)

JESUS AND MELCHIZEDEK

Remember, we just read in Hebrews 7 that we are to observe how great Melchizedek was! This teaching is not to place him above Jesus, but to show there is a connection between Jesus and Melchizedek. Repeatedly we see in Hebrews that Jesus is a High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

“So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, “You are My Son, Today I have begotten You”; just as He says also in another passage, “You are a priest forever According to the order of Melchizedek.” Hebrews 5:5-6 (NASB®)

“And having been made perfect, He became to all those who obey Him the source of eternal salvation, being designated by God as a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.” Hebrews 5:9-10 (NASB®)

"This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one which enters within the veil, where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, having become a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek." Hebrews 6:19-20 (NASB®)

Up until this divine appointment, the blessings that Abram received were only natural blessings based on all he could SEE. Natural blessings **to the seed which is compared to the dust of the earth.** Now, let's look closer at this blessing.

THE HEAVENLY BLESSING

Now that the foundation of Melchizedek has been laid, let's go back and examine this heavenly blessing that Abraham received.

"And Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine; now he was a priest of God Most High. He blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." He gave him a tenth of all." Genesis 14:18-20 (NASB®)

In this blessing Abram was reminded that he was **OF GOD MOST HIGH!** This is just like God's Word reminds us that we are of God! "**You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world.**" 1 John 4:4 (NASB®)

Abram was also reminded in this blessing that **the God he is from** is the **POSSESSOR OF NOT ONLY EARTH, BUT ALSO HEAVEN!** (Remember, satan is only the prince and power of the air, this natural realm. Ephesians 2:2. He is only temporarily the ruler of this world, i.e., *kósmos*-the world, the universe. John 12:31; Revelation 12:10)

It is obvious that since Melchizedek was a priest of God, he was trying to bring Abram to a higher level of thinking other than

what he could see in the natural realm. As we continue our study it will be obvious that there was a spiritual impartation of revelation presented, **and by faith Abram received it!**

THE THIRD BLESSING CONCERNING THE SEED OF ABRAM

*****Please remember that the number three is the number of completion, therefore this third special blessing completes the blessings to the seeds of Abram. *****

“After these things...” (Please note this is in chronological order, so this happened AFTER Abraham was blessed by Melchizedek.) “... the word of the LORD came to Abram in a vision, saying, “Do not fear, Abram, I am a shield to you; Your reward shall be very great.” Abram said, “O Lord GOD, what will You give me, since I am childless, and the heir of my house is Eliezer of Damascus?” And Abram said, “Since You have given no offspring to me, one born in my house is my heir.” Then behold, the word of the LORD came to him, saying, “This man will not be your heir; but one who will come forth from your own body, he shall be your heir.” And He took him outside and said, “Now look toward the heavens, and count the stars, if you are able to count them.” And He said to him, “So shall your descendants be.” Genesis 15:1-5 (NASB®)

We see a major shift in the substance of blessing **AFTER** Abram was blessed by Melchizedek. We see that God now tells Abram to “**look towards the heavens!**” Notice, there is nothing mentioned here concerning the “other seed” i.e., the dust of the earth. Those born of the dust of the earth do not look toward the heavens!

You see in 1 Corinthians we read, “*Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things freely given to us by God, which things we also speak, not in words taught by human wisdom, but in those taught by the*”

Spirit, combining spiritual thoughts with spiritual words. But a natural man..." (The earthly seed) "does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised." 1 Corinthians 2:12-14 (NASB®)

It was necessary for Abram to be taught of the Spirit concerning greater things that God had freely given him! I am speaking of spiritual things. As the scripture reads it is only a spiritual person who can receive the things of the Spirit, therefore Abram needed spiritual revelation to receive promises that would pertain to the unseen realm! God gave Abram a divine appointment with Melchizedek to open the eyes of his understanding to the things of the Spirit!

This new and fresh blessing had nothing to do with the natural realm, and it was all based on what was unseen! So, how did Abram respond to it? Genesis 15:6 (NASB®) says, "Then he believed in the Lord; and He reckoned it to him as righteousness." The spiritual blessings were "by faith" therefore it was contingent that Abram obey God and BELIEVE! God gives spiritual blessings to those who can RECEIVE them. He cannot give a spiritual blessing to one born of the flesh.

Now, even though Abram was given a spiritual impartation he still got in the flesh to try and "make" it come to pass. In Genesis 16:15 (NASB®) when Abram was 86 years old, we read, "...Hagar bore Abram a son; and Abram called the name of his son, whom Hagar bore, Ishmael."

THE BEGINNING OF NEW THINGS

Despite Abram's carnal motives in the flesh God was not done with him, for even AFTER Ishmael was born God was still yet at work making "all things new!" In Genesis 17:5 and 17:15 God gave Abram and Sarai new names! Right after this we read of the

marvelous promise of Isaac, the son of the free! God says, "I will bless her, (Sarah) and indeed I will give you a son by her. Then I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations; kings of peoples will come from her." Genesis 17:16 (NASB®)

Abraham responded in saying, "...Will a child be born to a man one hundred years old? And will Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?" Then he pleaded with God saying, "... Oh that Ishmael might live before You!" Genesis 17:17-18 (NASB®)

Just a special note here, remember Abraham was 86 when Ishmael was born (Genesis 16:15) and he was 100 when Isaac was born (Genesis 21:5) so there were 14 years between the two of them. With seven being the number of spiritual perfections it is evident that what was happening in the realm of the spirit was phenomenal! Isn't God's Word so perfect? (7+7=14-Isaac was double perfection!)

God gets the final word in this conversation. He is always in the business of making things better! God told Abraham, "... No, but Sarah your wife will bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; **and I will establish My covenant with him for an everlasting covenant for his descendants after him.** As for Ishmael, I have heard you; behold, I will bless him, and will make him fruitful and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall become the father of twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation. **But My covenant I will establish with Isaac,** whom Sarah will bear to you at this season next year." Genesis 17:19-21(NASB®)

THE TWO SEEDS

This is where things get interesting! You see Abraham had been interceding for Ishmael and God tells him, "As for Ishmael, I have heard you; behold, I will bless him, and will make him fruitful and will multiply him exceedingly. He shall become the father of twelve princes, and I will make him a great nation." Genesis 17:20-21 (NASB®)

Yes, there is a seed of people that are blessed, but hold on here, God says He will establish His covenant with Isaac and his descendants!

Now, to further put this in concrete we must know what a covenant is. You see a covenant is a promise with a contingency. A covenant is a promise based on two parties.

What is ironic is most of the promises in the Bible are covenants! Here is a clear example of a covenant, "If you continue in My word ..." (Pay attention because here is the contingency.) "... then you are truly disciples of Mine; and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free." John 8:31-32 (NASB®) We see here that on the flip side of this IF we do not continue in His Word then we are NOT His disciples, and He is under no obligation to reveal to us the truth that will make us free...we choose.

Now here is an example of a promise that is not a covenant. "*For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other created thing, will be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*" Romans 8:38-39 (NASB®) The love of God towards people is in no way contingent on anything in this world. God will always love people no matter what.

We now begin to see something special concerning the promised seed of Isaac. God must have KNOWN that Isaac would be a man who would fulfill his part of the covenant to receive the promise that was associated with it! Therefore, God told Abraham that He would bless Ishmael, and He honored the prayers of Abraham to bless him. But His everlasting covenant would be established with Isaac. God cannot make an everlasting covenant with someone who is NOT fulfilling their part of the covenant of promise. God must have known that Ishmael (Being born of the

bond, and a type of earthy seed) would not have been a doer of His Word.

SPIRITUAL SEEDS

Now, let's talk about spiritual seeds, what are they? We shall go to the book of Romans for further examination. *"But it is not as though the word of God has failed. For they are not all Israel who are descended from Israel; nor are they all children because they are Abraham's descendants, but: "through Isaac your descendants will be named." That is, it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants.*" Romans 9:6-8 (NASB®) Therefore we see that our genealogy matters not in the sight of God. (Remember Melchizedek had no genealogy yet he was a priest of God!) God's Word plainly says here that not all are children just because they are Abraham's descendants, but His spiritual seed is through the child who fulfilled his part of the covenant of promise. All who follow this same pattern are named as spiritual descendants.

While we are touching on this subject it is important that we know what God's Word plainly says about those who speak of genealogy. *"But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and strife and disputes about the Law, for they are unprofitable and worthless."* Titus 3:9 (NASB®)

Here in Timothy, we are told not to *"... pay attention to myths and endless genealogies, which give rise to mere speculation rather than furthering the administration of God which is by faith."* 1 Timothy 1:4 (NASB®) Genealogy matters not in the sight of God.

Though genealogy does not matter in the natural realm it is fascinating that Abraham was the first one listed in the genealogy of Jesus. (Matthew 1:1-2) He was founded on faith and justified by faith. Concerning Abraham, it is written, *"In hope against hope he believed, so that he might become a father of many nations according to*

that which had been spoken, "So shall your descendants be." Romans 4:18 (NASB®)

OBEDIENCE IS BETTER THAN SACRIFICE

Why did God reject Saul from being a king? Is it not amazing that God rejected Saul from being a king for his repeated offerings for sin? True, God gave the law, but the burnt offerings for sin were not His ultimate desire.

Samuel asks Saul, "Has the Lord as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams. "For rebellion is as the sin of divination, And insubordination is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He has also rejected you from being king." Then Saul said to Samuel, "I have sinned; I have indeed transgressed the command of the Lord and your words, because I feared the people and listened to their voice."¹ Samuel 15:22-24 (NASB®)

It was not like Saul was not making a sacrifice under the law for his sin. Saul gave offerings over and over like many people still repeatedly go to the altar today, but what is the desire of God's heart? Obedience to His Word is God's desire.

The only sacrifice that God desires is for us to become like what Isaac was, a living sacrifice! The only way we can do that is to renew our carnal thinking by and through God's Word. "Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect." Romans 12:1-2 (NASB®)

A life of disobedience is a carnal mindset that only leads to death. A life of obedience to God's Word is a living sacrifice,

spiritually minded, completely sold out to His perfect will-which results in life and peace! (Romans 8:6)

A COVENANT CAN ONLY BE ESTABLISHED WITH A DOER OF GOD'S WORD

If one is not a doer of His Word, they are living a life of deception believing they are His seed. *"But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks at his natural face in a mirror; for once he has looked at himself and gone away, he has immediately forgotten what kind of person he was."* James 1:22-24 (NASB®) This man is looking only at his natural face, (He is looking at what he can see.) instead of the Christ in him-the hope of glory! (Colossians 1:27)

His true remnant is the spiritual seed created in the image of His Son. *"But we..."* (The heavenly seed.) *"... all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord..."* (What are we beholding as in a mirror? We are not looking at our natural face, for we are too focused on what is unseen, beholding the glory of the Lord!) *"...are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit."* 2 Corinthians 3:18 (NASB®) We are being transformed because our focus is heavenly, not earthly!

"For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren" Romans 8:29(NASB®)

To believe is to obey. The proof we have received His Word is that we are doers of His Word.

"For it is not merely hearing the Law [read] that makes one righteous before God, but it is the doers of the Law who will be held guiltless and acquitted and justified." Romans 2:13 (AMPC)

PROMISES TO A SINGULAR SEED

In Galatians God says, "Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, "And to seeds," as referring to many, but rather to one, "And to your seed," that is, Christ." Galatians 3:16 This scripture plainly indicates the word "seed" here is NOT plural. In Galatians it is obvious who this SEED is. "And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's descendants, heirs according to promise." Galatians 3:29 (NASB®)

In Luke 8:11 we read, "...the seed is the word of God." Do you know what is amazing about Jesus? He IS the Word of God! "And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us..." John 1:14 You cannot separate the written Word from the Living Word! With this being said let's look at this passage, "He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. BUT as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name," John 1:11-12(NASB®) What is His name? "He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God." Revelation 19:13 (NASB®)

Remember, concerning the descendants of Abraham we just read in Romans 9:8 (NASB®) "... it is not the children of the flesh who are children of God, but the children of the promise are regarded as descendants." Well, we clearly see here in John that it is those who received Jesus (God's Word) and believed Him, that He gave the right to become the children of God!

We see here that if we continue in the Word of God (being doers and not hearers only) we do belong to Jesus, and we are part of this heavenly seed of Abraham, not the seeds as in the earthly and heavenly, but the heavenly only!

Jesus told the religious people (the earthly seed of Abraham) "I know that you are Abraham's descendants; yet you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you." John

8:37(NASB®) God's Word is truth, but there is a seed that will not receive truth for it has no place in them, therefore they are born of a lie.

Moving on in John He tells the religious people, "*You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own nature, for he is a liar and the father of lies.*" John 8:44 (NASB®) Do you remember what God told satan when He cursed Him for perverting His Words? If you do not, let's look at it now, for we must see that God **said satan has a seed!**

LONG BEFORE ABRAHAM

"The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this..." (What did satan do? He perverted the precious truth of God's Word when he deceived Eve.) "... Cursed are you more than all cattle, And more than every beast of the field; On your belly you will go, And dust you will eat All the days of your life; And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed..." (Those born of the flesh; dust, earthly minded...this is ultimately satan's seed.) "...and her seed...;" (Those born of the Spirit; the stars, heavenly minded. The mother of those born of the Spirit is New Jerusalem! We will go into this further in a moment. Galatians 4:26; Revelation 21:2 & 10) "...He shall bruise you on the head..." (Now reading this in context, we see clearly it is the heavenly seed bruising satan on the head.) "... And you shall bruise him on the heel." (And of course, this is satan bruising the heel of the heavenly seed.) Genesis 3:14-15 (NASB®)

Something else notable to point out here is God cursed satan and part of the curse was that he would eat dust all the days of his life. Does this not sound familiar? Remember the first blessing that God gave Abraham? "*I will make your descendants as the dust of the*

earth, so that if anyone can number the dust of the earth, your descendants can also be numbered.” Genesis 13:16 (NASB®)

The word **dust** here in both passages is the same word. In the Hebrew it is *aphar* (Strong’s #6083) and means dry earth, dust. Therefore, we see plainly that satan is consuming those who are of the **dust** of the earth (The earthly seed of Abraham; ultimately satan’s seed.) because of their carnality. The scripture said God told satan, “*dust you will eat.*”

“Be of sober spirit, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.” 1 Peter 5:8 (NASB®) This does not say the adversary looks for someone to tempt, no he wants to completely devour those whom he can—those whose walk is by sight! Those who walk by sight cannot be heavenly-minded, and if they are not heavenly-minded they will be devoured because they walk by sight. God has given satan permission to devour the dust of the earth. (The earthly seed—the seed of satan.) To be carnally minded is DEATH! To be spiritually minded is LIFE AND PEACE! (Romans 8:6)

When Paul was deserted for his teachings, he says this, “*...the Lord stood with me and strengthened me, so that through me the proclamation might be fully accomplished, and that all the Gentiles might hear; **and I was rescued out of the lion’s mouth.***” 2 Timothy 4:17 (NASB®) Paul was this heavenly seed whom the enemy was not able to consume!

*“We know [absolutely] that anyone born of God does not [deliberately and knowingly] practice committing sin, but the One Who was begotten of God carefully watches over and protects him [Christ’s divine presence within him preserves him against the evil], **and the wicked one does not lay hold (get a grip) on him or touch [him].**” 1 John 5:18 (AMPC)*

This heavenly seed is born of God (from above), and they do not practice sin (Sin is unbelief.) and satan cannot touch them! There is no mention anywhere in God's Word that God gave satan permission to eat the stars, i.e., the heavenly seed, because he cannot touch us! Glory!

THE ONE BORN OF THE FLESH PERSECUTING THE ONE BORN OF THE SPIRIT

Rebekah was Isaac's mom, and she was blessed in this manner, "*May you, our sister, Become thousands of ten thousands, And may your descendants possess The gate of those who hate them.*" Genesis 24:60 (NASB®) Wait a minute, this blessed heavenly seed has enemies? Who are the enemies of this heavenly seed?

We find this answer in Genesis 21:9. "*Now Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Abraham, mocking [Isaac].*" Genesis 21:9(AMPC) Yes, this mocking is (Strongs#6711) in the Hebrew, and it is clearly defined as to laugh outright (in merriment or scorn); by implication, to sport -- laugh, mock, play, make sport.

It is the one who was born of the flesh (earthly) Ishmael who was mocking Isaac, the one born of the Spirit (heavenly). **Ishmael is called the one born according to the flesh because Abraham got ahead of God and tried to fulfill the promise BEFORE the appointed time of Isaac. Ishmael will always represent works of the flesh i.e., dead works absent of the presence of God not prompted by the Holy Spirit.** "*That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.*" John 3:6 (NASB®)

Even Jesus warned us about those born of the flesh when He said, "*They will make you outcasts from the synagogue, but an hour is coming for everyone who kills you to think that he is offering service to God. These things they will do because they have not known the Father or*

Me." John 16:2-3 (NASB®) This is clearly the earthly seed, those born of religion instead of a relationship for they believe they will be serving God when they are persecuting the heavenly seed.

We see this concept clearly in the epistle of Galatians. *"For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by the bondwoman and one by the free woman. But the son by the bondwoman was born according to the flesh, and the son by the free woman through the promise. This is allegorically speaking, for these women are **two covenants**: one proceeding from Mount Sinai bearing children who are to be slaves; she is Hagar. Now this Hagar is Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the **present Jerusalem...**" (Natural Jerusalem; what is seen presently.) *"... for she is in slavery with her children. But the **Jerusalem above is free; she is our mother.**" (The Heavenly Jerusalem; what is unseen.) *"... For it is written, "REJOICE, BARREN WOMAN WHO DOES NOT BEAR; BREAK FORTH AND SHOUT, YOU WHO ARE NOT IN LABOR; FOR MORE NUMEROUS ARE THE CHILDREN OF THE DESOLATE THAN OF THE ONE WHO HAS A HUSBAND." And you brethren, like Isaac, are children of promise. But as at that time he who was born according to the flesh persecuted him who was born according to the Spirit, so it is now also. But what does the Scripture say? "CAST OUT THE BONDWOMAN AND HER SON, FOR THE SON OF THE BONDWOMAN SHALL NOT BE AN HEIR WITH THE SON OF THE FREE WOMAN." So then, brethren, we are not children of a bondwoman, but of the free woman." Galatians 4:22-31 (NASB®)***

PRESENT JERUSALEM

We noticed there in Galatians that the present Jerusalem (the earthly) corresponds to slavery, right? Now please notice how God is calling Jerusalem upward even here in Isaiah! *"Shake yourself from the dust, **rise up, O captive Jerusalem; Loose yourself from the chains around your neck, O captive daughter of Zion.**" Isaiah 52:2 (NASB®)*

In Matthew 23 when Jesus was talking to His disciples concerning the scribes and the Pharisees (again the earthly seed) He

expresses that His ultimate desire was to gather the children of Jerusalem (The earthly seed born in bondage like Galatians explained.) However, they only wanted to persecute the heavenly seed! *“Jerusalem, Jerusalem, who kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to her! How often I wanted to gather your children together, the way a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, and you were unwilling.”* Matthew 23:37 (NASB®)

NEW JERUSALEM

We touched on this briefly in the section entitled **LONG BEFORE ABRAHAM**, but it is clearly seen who New Jerusalem is in Revelation 21. In John’s vision he says, *“And I saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, made ready as a bride adorned for her husband.”* Revelation 21:2 (NASB®)

Then in verse 10 he begins to talk more about this new Jerusalem. *“And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the holy city, Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God,”* Revelation 21:10 (NASB®)

Remember in the previous section we spoke of satan’s seed and “her seed?” Well, this “woman” is the Jerusalem in Revelation 21:2 & 10, and she is the same Jerusalem that Galatians is referring to! This heavenly Jerusalem from above. She is the mother of the free, i.e., the heavenly seed! Glory!

The heavenly seed MUST have a heavenly Father, AND a heavenly mother! Jerusalem above is FREE; she is our mother!

This is the same “city” that Abraham began to look for! *“for he [Abraham] was looking for the city which has foundations, whose architect and builder is God.”* Hebrews 11:10 (NASB®) This is the same “city” in which the heavenly seed expects to find “outside the camp.” *“So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His*

reproach. For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come.” Hebrews 13:13-14 (NASB®)

WHAT DOES THIS HEAVENLY SEED LOOK LIKE?

The heavenly seed has a Father which is in heaven (Matthew 6:9) and they do not serve the father of lies-the devil. (John 8:44)

By faith, they are praying and believing that His will is going to be done in earth as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10)

By faith, the heavenly seed has been born again from above for they know that unless this happens, they can never be acquainted with anything that pertains to the kingdom of God! (John 3:3)

By faith, this heavenly seed knows that His kingdom is NOT of this world. (John 18:36) No, this kingdom does not originate from anything that is “seen” as in the natural realm. (Luke 17:20-21) Yet, this heavenly seed chose to seek first His Kingdom, and His righteousness! (Matthew 6:33)

Though this kingdom of heaven suffers violent attacks by faith it is this heavenly seed that seizes it by force. (Matthew 11:12)

By faith, this heavenly seed knows it is through many tribulations that we enter the kingdom of God. (Acts 14:22)

By faith, this seed prefers to store their treasures in their dwelling place-heaven! They know where their treasure is, so their heart will be also! (Matthew 6:20-21)

By faith, this seed has a hope laid up in heaven because they have received the Word of truth i.e., God’s Word. (Colossians 1:5)

By faith, this seed knows that they have been raised up with Him and seated with Him in heavenly places in Christ Jesus! (Ephesians 2:6) Jesus declared to the religious people **as He was still standing on earth**, *“You are from below, **I am from above**; you are of this world, **I am not of this world**.”* (John 8:23) Therefore, by faith this heavenly seed knows **they have all rights to make this same proclamation here in the world for they know as He is, so also they are in this world!** (1 John 4:17)

Since they continually reside in heaven, this seed knows they have been blessed with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realm! (Ephesians 1:3)

By faith, they have full knowledge that this heavenly seating is truly with Christ at God’s right hand far above all rule and authority and power and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in the one to come. (Ephesians 1:20-21)

By faith, they are not moved by “feelings” so despite the fact they “feel” like strangers and aliens, they know instead they are fellow citizens with the saints and are of God’s household! (Ephesians 2:19)

By faith, their desire is that they may be found “in Him” not having a man-made carnal righteousness from the law, BUT that which **is through faith in Christ, the righteousness which comes from God on the basis of faith!** (Philippians 3:9)

Philippians 3:20 says, *“...our citizenship is in heaven...”* In the Greek, this word *citizenship* is *politeuma* (Strong’s #4175) and it means a form of government, citizenship. By faith this heavenly seed knows this is a seat of government in which they are citizens, and as heavenly citizens not only do they have **heavenly rights, BUT ALSO heavenly responsibilities!**

By faith, the heavenly seed knows that since they have the keys to the kingdom of heaven, they have everything they need to carry out their responsibilities in binding the things on earth, in accordance with how they are bound in heaven, and loosing on earth what is already loosed in heaven. (Matthew 16:19)

By faith, they know that just like Jesus they possess everything that the Father has, and just like Jesus they know all authority has been given to them in heaven, and on earth! (John 16:14-15 & Matthew 28:18)

By faith, they have been qualified to be partakers of this heavenly calling that Hebrews 3:1 speaks of!

By faith, the heavenly seed continues to press towards the goal for the prize of the UPWARD call of God in Christ Jesus. (Philippians 3:14)

By faith, their focus is not on temporary things which are seen, (like the other seed) but their focus is on things which are unseen and eternal for they walk by faith and not by sight. (2 Corinthians 4:18 & 2 Corinthians 5:7)

They continue to build themselves up founded on their most holy faith, rising like an edifice higher and higher praying in the Holy Spirit! (Jude 20)

THE LANGUAGE OF THE HEAVENLY SEED

By faith, the heavenly seed believes that "He who comes from above is above all, he who is of the earth is from the earth and speaks of the earth...." John 3:31 (NASB®) Therefore by faith, the conversation of this seed will not speak of things pertaining to earth i.e., the natural realm, for in their heavenly seating they are far above the natural circumstances!

By faith since they have been raised with Christ, they continue to seek things above! It is no longer an option to have their mind set on things of the earth for they have died to everything pertaining to the flesh (the carnal realm) and their life is hidden with Christ in God.

By faith in continuing in this heavenly mindset they know that Christ is their life and when He is revealed they also will be revealed with Him in glory! (Colossians 3:1-4) They are fully convinced that when they are “in Him” they are everything that He is!

WARFARE IN THIS HEAVENLY REALM

“For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of his darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.” Ephesians 6:12 (NASB®) The heavenly seed knows this battle is all spiritual.

How could we expect to fight against spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places if we were not already there? There is a battle in the heavenly realm, two kingdoms are warring, and we must be born of this heavenly seed to fight this battle remaining in our heavenly position.

THE FIRST ADAM, AND THE SECOND ADAM

It is obvious the two seeds are found all through the Word of God, even before Abraham, so let’s aim our focus now more towards this untouchable seed!

“Thus it is written, The first man Adam became a living being (an individual personality); the last Adam (Christ) became a life-giving Spirit [restoring the dead to life]. But it is not the spiritual life which came first, but the physical and then the spiritual. The first man [was] from

out of earth, made of dust (earthly-minded); the second Man [is] the Lord from out of heaven. Now those who are made of the dust are like him who was first made of the dust (earthly-minded);” (Remember, Eve was deceived when she believed the lie from satan, verses what God had told her. Adam was disobedient and went along with Eve.) “and as is [the Man] from heaven, so also [are those] who are of heaven (heavenly-minded). And just as we have borne the image [of the man] of dust, so shall we and so let us also bear the image [of the Man] of heaven.” 1 Corinthians 15:45-49 (AMPC)

Yes, we are here in a natural body bearing the image of the man of the dust (Adam), but we choose whether we come up higher and bear the image of the One born from above Who is heavenly minded! “Let this same attitude and purpose and [humble] mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus: [Let Him be your example in humility:]” Philippians 2:5 (AMPC)

THE LAW IS SPIRITUAL

Paul explains in Romans 7:14 that the law is spiritual. You see God is Spirit, and anything that comes from Him MUST be spiritual. However, man could not see the spiritual side of the law because of his carnality, therefore God sent His only Son Who is part of this heavenly/spiritual seed.

What was the purpose of the law? “Therefore the Law has become our tutor to lead us to Christ, so that we may be justified by faith. But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a tutor.” Galatians 3:24-25 (NASB®) Glory! We are no longer under anything associated with a tutor that would keep us under carnal ordinances, for we as the heavenly seed walk by faith and not by sight!

Paul warns the people who were going back under the works of the law. “If you have died with Christ to the elementary principles of the world, why, as if you were living in the world, do

you submit yourself to decrees, such as, “Do not handle, do not taste, do not touch!” (which all refer to things destined to perish with use)—in accordance with the commandments and teachings of men? These are matters which have, to be sure, the appearance of wisdom in self-made religion and self-abasement and severe treatment of the body, but are of no value against fleshly indulgence.” Colossians 2:20-23 (NASB®) Only the heavenly seed will have died to all the carnal ordinances that come with a man-made religion based on what is “seen.”

When we have died with Christ it is all a walk by faith, being no longer in bondage to the law. “For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.” Romans 10:4 (NASB®) Do you believe it?

Let’s move on here in Galatians 3. *“For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus...”* How do we become sons? We become sons through faith! *“... For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free man, there is neither male nor female; **for you are all one in Christ Jesus. And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s descendants, heirs according to promise.**”* Galatians 3:26-29 (NASB®)

Jesus said, *“Do not presume that I came to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I did not come to abolish, but to fulfill.”* Matthew 5:17 (NASB®) Christ did not come to destroy the law but to fulfill the law! He fulfilled every “jot and tittle” of the carnal ordinances of the law. He already fulfilled all of this for the heavenly seed!

THE FIRST COVENANT HAD REGULATIONS

“Now even the first covenant had regulations of divine worship and the earthly sanctuary.” Hebrews 9:1(NASB®) Despite the spiritual impartation given, there was still a carnal nature of

“works” associated with the first covenant. However, when God gave His Son a whole new and better way of living was established!

“But when Christ appeared as a high priest of the good things to come, He entered through the greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this creation; and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?” Hebrews 9:11-14 (NASB®) Christ made the switch from the carnal to the spiritual once and for all! It is by His precious blood that we have been cleansed once and for all from dead unfruitful works of religion to serve the Living God!

*“For this reason He is the mediator of a **new covenant**, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance. For where a covenant is, there must of necessity be the death of the one who made it. For a covenant is valid only when men are dead, for it is never in force while the one who made it lives.”* Hebrews 9:15-17 (NASB®) Under the first covenant God was establishing through Abraham and Isaac, Abraham was willing to sacrifice Isaac for it, but God saw his faith and provided a ram instead. Remember, as Isaac was a living sacrifice so are we. (Romans 12:1)

PERFECTION

“For the Law, since it has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the very form of things, can never, by the same sacrifices which they offer continually year by year, make perfect those who draw near.” Hebrews 10:1 (NASB®) Wait, what exactly

does this mean? Can those who draw near to Him be perfected? Let's read on!

*"But in those sacrifices..." (The carnal sacrifices under the law.) "... there is a reminder of sins year by year. For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. Therefore, when He comes into the world, He says, "SACRIFICE AND OFFERING YOU HAVE NOT DESIRED, BUT A BODY YOU HAVE PREPARED FOR ME; IN WHOLE BURNT OFFERINGS AND sacrifices FOR SIN YOU HAVE TAKEN NO PLEASURE. "THEN I SAID, 'BEHOLD, I HAVE COME (IN THE SCROLL OF THE BOOK IT IS WRITTEN OF ME) TO DO YOUR WILL, O GOD.'" After saying above, "SACRIFICES AND OFFERINGS AND WHOLE BURNT OFFERINGS AND sacrifices FOR SIN YOU HAVE NOT DESIRED, NOR HAVE YOU TAKEN PLEASURE in them" (which are offered according to the Law), then He said, "BEHOLD, I HAVE COME TO DO YOUR WILL." **He takes away the first in order to establish the second. By this will we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.**" Hebrews 10:3-10 (NASB®) No longer are we constantly reminded of sins, for by the blood of Jesus we have been sanctified once and for all!*

"Every priest stands daily ministering and offering time after time the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins; but He, having offered one sacrifice for sins for all time, sat down at the right hand of God, waiting from that time onward until His enemies be made a footstool for His feet. For by one offering He has perfected for all time those who are sanctified." Hebrews 10:11-14 (NASB®) So yeah, those who are sanctified are also able to walk in perfection! Glory!

"Therefore, brethren, since we have confidence to enter the holy place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way which He inaugurated for us through the veil, that is, His flesh," Hebrews 10:19-20 (NASB®) A new and living way.... Spiritual perfection!

"For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy place by the high priest as an offering for sin, are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His

own blood, suffered outside the gate. So, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach." Hebrews 13:11-13 (NASB®) Jesus was persecuted by those born of the flesh, so also are those who have His mindset.

Now, since we have a new and living way which He inaugurated for us isn't it time to "come up higher?" It does not matter where you are spiritually there is always a higher realm of perfection "in Him." **There are no boundaries to promotion in the heavenly realm!**

In this scripture of reproof, we see how God's Word is calling His people to yet again, "come up higher!" "Therefore let us go on and get past the elementary stage in the teachings and doctrine of Christ (the Messiah), advancing steadily toward the completeness and perfection that belong to spiritual maturity. Let us not again be laying the foundation of repentance and abandonment of dead works (dead formalism) and of the faith [by which you turned] to God, With teachings about purifying, the laying on of hands, the resurrection from the dead, and eternal judgment and punishment. [These are all matters of which you should have been fully aware long, long ago.]" Hebrews 6:1-2 (AMPC) He is saying, take what you know but always be pressing into the realm of the Spirit desiring further advancement, and maturity. This advancement will only come through an intimate relationship with Him, not under the doctrines and commandments of men.

THE HEAVENLY SEED, THE REMNANT

Remember this is another promise that God made to Abraham's seed. "indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed (this is singular) shall possess the gate of their enemies." Genesis 22:17 (NASB®) Only those who are of a heavenly seed will possess the gates of their enemies because they will have received the promise of the covenants

because they will have fulfilled their part. Their enemy of course is the “other seed.” The ones disobedient to God’s covenants. Remember the one born of the flesh persecuted the one born of the Spirit.

In the section entitled **PROMISES TO A SINGULAR SEED** we read Galatians 3:16(NASB®), “Now the promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. He does not say, “And to seeds,” as referring to many, but rather to one, “And to your seed,” that is, Christ.” Christ is the incorruptible seed that we are born of. He is the Word of God. He is the original incorruptible seed. “for you have been born again not of seed which is perishable but imperishable, that is, through the living and enduring word of God.” 1 Peter 1:23 (NASB®) Again, there is no separation between the written Word and the Living Word, “The seed is the Word of God.” Luke 8:11 (AMPC)

Now, the heavenly seed that is born of the incorruptible seed is obedient to God’s Word, because God’s Word abides in him. “No one who is born of God practices sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.” 1 John 3:9 Remember unbelief is sin. That is why His Word tells us, “Take care, brethren, that there not be in any one of you an evil, unbelieving heart that falls away from the living God.” Hebrews 3:12(NASB®)

When we continue in His Word, being doers of His Word, there is no room for us to walk in unbelief, (Which is practicing sin.) for faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. (Romans 10:17)

THE HEAVENLY SEED AND THE FIRE

“In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;” 1 Peter 1:6-7 (NASB®) The faith of the

heavenly seed is being tried just as gold is tried in a fire, but remember though satan sifts the wheat God burns the chaff! (Luke 22:31; Hebrews 12:29) Remember the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the holy place by the high priest as an offering for sin, are burned outside the camp. We must allow God to burn any chaff of unbelief in us as we present our bodies as a living sacrifice.

What is the message to the carnal church of Laodicea? *"I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth. Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked..."* It is because of what they SAW that they had need of nothing in their own eyes in the natural realm, no need to trust in God. But what advice does God's Word give to them? Remember this is still to come! *"...I advise you to buy from Me gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see."* Revelation 3:15-18 (NASB®) So that they would see what? In order that they could see their need to come up higher into that heavenly realm!

When we allow God to burn the chaff there will remain a holy seed! *"Yet there will be a tenth portion in it, And it will again be subject to burning, Like a terebinth or an oak Whose stump remains when it is felled. The holy seed is its stump."* Isaiah 6:13 (NASB®) We urge you to go back and read this in context. This scripture is in relation to Isaiah's commission and despite all that will happen the encouragement here is that there will be a holy seed that remains, and this holy seed is His remnant.

Remember what we said about God's covenant being established in Isaac? Well Jacob is Isaac's son. (Genesis 25:21-26) God changed Jacob's name to Israel because he had struggled with

God and man, and yet he overcame! (Genesis 32:27-28) What was so significant about the name Israel that God chose that name as Jacob's new name? The name Israel means spiritual seed. In Exodus 4:22, and Jeremiah 31:9 God clearly says that Israel is His son, and He is a Father to Israel! Since God is Spirit, (John 4:24) then His sons are a spiritual seed! Glory!

Now, keeping this in mind let's examine the depth of what this scripture is saying. *"Isaiah cries out concerning Israel, "Though the number of the sons of Israel be like the sand of the sea, **it is the remnant that will be saved;**"* Romans 9:27 (NASB®) **Nothing is promised here about the sand of the sea being saved, only the remnant.**

COME UP HIGHER!

If you have been convicted by the Holy Spirit through this teaching, then maybe it is time to take the advice of the voice in Revelation and *"Come up here..."* for when we come up higher do we not realize that He will *"... show you what must take place after these things."* Revelation 4:1 (NASB®)

In Matthew 8:5-13 (NASB®) we read of the centurion who became a heavenly seed. How did this happen? He believed in the power of the word that Jesus spoke. The proof that he was qualified to be a part of this heavenly seed is seen in how Jesus responded for we read, *"Now when Jesus heard this, [Jesus heard the confession of his faith.] He marveled and said to those who were following, "Truly I say to you, I have not found such great faith with anyone in Israel...."* [Who was in Israel? There were many of Abraham's religious descendants by blood in Israel, the earthly seed.] Then Jesus declares this, *"... I say to you that **many will come from east and west, and recline at the table with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven...."*** [The heavenly seed!] *"... but the sons of the kingdom will be cast out into the outer darkness; in that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."*

Wow, Jesus Himself calls these guys “sons of the kingdom.” This is the “other seed” whose dwelling is not in the kingdom of heaven now, therefore there will be no entitlement to recline at the table with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven at any future time.

Concerning the coming of the Lord we read these passages in the gospels:

“I tell you, on that night there will be two in one bed; one will be taken and the other will be left. There will be two women grinding at the same place; one will be taken and the other will be left. [Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other will be left.”] Luke 17:34-36 (NASB®)

“Then there will be two men in the field; one will be taken and one will be left. Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken and one will be left.” Matthew 24:40-41 (NASB®)

There is a separation between the two seeds, the wheat, and the tares, the goats and the sheep, the believers and the make-believers, **the hearers of God’s Word and the doers of God’s Word.** One will be taken just as in the days of Noah when the wicked one was removed, but the overcomer will remain!

“LIFT UP YOUR EYES ON HIGH AND SEE WHO HAS CREATED THESE STARS, THE ONE WHO LEADS FORTH THEIR HOST BY NUMBER, HE CALLS THEM ALL BY NAME; BECAUSE OF THE GREATNESS OF HIS MIGHT AND THE STRENGTH OF HIS POWER, NOT ONE OF THEM IS MISSING.” Isaiah 40:26 (NASB®) **THE HEAVENLY SEED!**

LOOK UP!

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“Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you:” 2 Thessalonians 3:1

“So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.” Acts 19:20

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
