BLESSED
CANNOT
BE
CURSED

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There is a great deception in the body of Christ today, that truly needs the light of God's Word (i.e. the truth of the scriptures) to expose the darkness. This outright lie, that originated from the father of lies, has had many Christians deceived for far too long. So, what is this lie? I am referring to a polluted message that the powers of darkness can place effective curses on the lives of righteous men and women of God.

Before we get into the revelation of the truth of the matter, I want you to see what this lie promotes. Jesus told us over and over in the gospels that before the coming of the Son of man that there would be deception, but He reminded us constantly, "Do not be deceived."

Fear is at the very root of this deception. If the enemy can just get you to fear curses of witchcraft, he can paralyze the believer from walking out their purpose and call. This has happened to far too many believers.

Before we begin this study through the scriptures, I only ask that you pray and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to you what He wants you to receive in order that it may edify and encourage you to continue to "seek first the Kingdom of God."

THE TRUTH OF THE MATTER

We all know it is in God's Word that we should "...*bless, and curse not.*" Romans 12:14 (KJV) Yes, this scripture was written specifically concerning those who persecute us; however, it is not God's will for curses to come out of our mouths, for our words carry tremendous power.

For a prime example we have the story of Balak and Balaam in Numbers 23-24. Having read this story, we know that Balak had hired Balaam to curse his enemies, which were the children of Israel. Balak attempted to get Balaam to curse the children of Israel three times. Each time we read that the Spirit

of the Lord moved upon Balaam and the words given from God to the children of Israel through Balaam were blessings rather than curses. (Numbers 23:5; 23:16; 24:2)

It may have looked like this scheme was going to prevail when Balak had made plans in his own heart, but God had the last say. Therefore, we read further that Balak was angered at Balaam's obedience to God and said, "*...I called thee to curse mine enemies, and, behold, thou hast altogether blessed them these three times.*" Numbers 24:10 (KJV)

Balaam replied, "*...Did I not also speak to your messengers whom you sent to me, saying, 'If Balak were to give me his house full of silver and gold, I could not go beyond the word of the Lord, to do good or bad of my own will. What the Lord says, that I must speak'?*" Numbers 24:12-13 (NKJV)

WHAT WAS MEANT FOR EVIL GOD TURNED FOR GOOD

In the natural it appeared that Balaam was on the job and that the gates and plans of hell conjured in man's heart would be the destiny for the children of Israel; however, if they had God's blessing, they could not be cursed, and therefore God had the final say. Balak, "*... hired Balaam against them to curse them. However, our God turned the curse into a blessing.*" Nehemiah 13:2 (NASB)

Balak sought to oppose Israel through pagan divination, sending for Balaam to put a curse on the Israelites; however, God saved Israel by causing Balaam to bless instead of curse. God cannot lie; therefore, He was required to turn any curses against the children of Israel into blessings, as long as they were walking in obedience. Why? Let's look at the covenants that He made with us in Deuteronomy 28.

BLESSING OR CURSING...YOU CHOOSE

The very first thing mentioned here in Deuteronomy 28 is, “Now it shall be, if you diligently obey the Lord your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth. All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you obey the Lord your God.” Deuteronomy 28:1-2 (NASB) Then we read in verses 3-14 all these amazing blessings that God promised them! You are blessed in the city, blessed in the country, blessed when you come in and go out, and all that we do! In verse seven He even promises us protection against our enemies. “The Lord shall cause your enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before you; they will come out against you one way and will flee before you seven ways.” Deuteronomy 28:7 (NASB) Come on, what do we do with these promises? Will we receive them?

Now, it is important to see the actual root of how a curse can come upon someone's life, so let's read on beginning with Deuteronomy 28:15.

“But it shall come about, if you do not obey the Lord your God, to observe to do all His commandments and His statutes with which I charge you today, that all these curses will come upon you and overtake you.” Verses 16-68 are exactly opposite of all the blessings contained in verses 3-14. And, oh how many more curses there are than blessings! Contrary to blessings people can be cursed in the city, cursed in the country, cursed when you come in and go out, and all that they do! These curses are directly related to personal disobedience and have nothing to do with the outside influence of word curses from someone else. This is self-explanatory. Obedience to God and His ways always results in blessings, disobedience always results in curses. People walking in rebellion to God's Word even lose His protection over their lives, “The Lord shall cause you to be defeated before your enemies; you will go out one way against

them, but you will flee seven ways before them, and you will be an example of terror to all the kingdoms of the earth.” Deuteronomy 28:25 (NASB)

CHOOSE LIFE

A few chapters later in Deuteronomy we read this, “See, I have set before you today life and prosperity, and death and adversity; in that I command you today to love the Lord your God, to walk in His ways and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you may live and multiply, and that the Lord your God may bless you in the land where you are entering to possess it. But if your heart turns away and you will not obey, but are drawn away and worship other gods and serve them, I declare to you today that you shall surely perish. You will not prolong your days in the land where you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess it. I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. So choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding fast to Him; for this is your life and the length of your days, that you may live in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them.” Deuteronomy 30:15-20 (NASB)

WHAT RESULTED IN THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL BEING CURSED?

Though God was for the children of Israel, and no weapon formed against them could prosper, it did not continue like that. In Numbers 25 we read, *“While Israel remained at Shittim, the people began to play the harlot with the daughters of Moab. For they invited the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. So Israel joined themselves to Baal of Peor, and the Lord was angry against Israel.” Numbers 25:1-3 (NASB)* Can we not clearly see now

what caused the blessed children of Israel, who could not be cursed by man, to have such a horrible ending? It was not God. They made a choice in their rebellion. They broke their covenant with God. This is not meant to be a condemning message, but rather relaying insight into the principles of how to walk in blessings!

These children that were living in the blessing of God chose to move into full blown idolatry, which as we know is putting other gods before the only true God. As you continue to read on in verses 4-9, we see how this resulted in the death of over 24,000 Israelites.

So, who was to blame? Let's continue to rightly divide God's Word and come to the truth of the matter.

THE REAL WITCHCRAFT THAT IS OCCURRING

The plain and simple truth is like unto the message that Samuel gave Saul in 1 Samuel 15, *"So Samuel said: "Has the Lord as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the Lord? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, And stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the Lord, He also has rejected you from being king."* 1 Samuel 15:22-23 (NASB) So, what is true witchcraft according to God's Word? Rebellion is the sin of witchcraft! If we can just receive the revelation of this and apply it, what a waterfall of blessings we would live in!

We all know what John 3:16 (AMPC) says, *"For God so greatly loved and dearly prized the world that He [even] gave up His only begotten (unique) Son, so that whoever believes in (trusts in, clings to, relies on) Him shall not perish (come to destruction, be lost) but have eternal (everlasting) life."*

However, let's keep reading John 3, down to verse 36. *"And he who believes in (has faith in, clings to, relies on) the Son has (now possesses) eternal life. But whoever disobeys (is unbelieving toward, refuses to trust in, disregards, is not subject to) the Son will never see (experience) life, but [instead] the wrath of God abides on him. [God's displeasure remains on him; His indignation hangs over him continually.]"* John 3:36 (AMPC)

DANGERS OF DISOBEDIENCE

But something happened, it was kind of like a type and shadow of what happened in the Garden of Eden with Adam and Eve.

In Genesis 3 Eve heard a lie, but that was not her sin. The downfall was that she began to believe that lie, instead of what God had told Adam in Genesis 2:15-17 when He put him in charge of the Garden of Eden to keep it.

Then, Eve acted on that lying word, and convinced Adam to as well. Up until this point, Adam and Eve were so blessed! They didn't even know that they were naked, because God was their covering. They knew nothing evil. The real disobedience here was unbelief in what God had said. They chose to believe satan's lies over God's truth.

LIVING IN DISOBEDIENCE...BUT BLAMING GOD

Many people live in disobedience and then want to blame God or blame it on a "curse" that someone spoke over them. Though we sometimes we have trials, if we are doers of God's word and not hearers only...we cannot be cursed. Why? *"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."* Galatians 3:13-14 (NKJV)

CHILDREN RECEIVE DISCIPLINE

In Hebrews we are reminded of the relationship God has with His own children. *“...‘My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, Nor faint when you are reproved by Him; For those whom the Lord loves He disciplines, And He scourges every son whom He receives.’ It is for discipline that you endure; God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom his father does not discipline? But if you are without discipline, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. Furthermore, we had earthly fathers to discipline us, and we respected them; shall we not much rather be subject to the Father of spirits, and live? For they disciplined us for a short time as seemed best to them, but He disciplines us for our good, so that we may share His holiness. All discipline for the moment seems not to be joyful, but sorrowful; yet to those who have been trained by it, afterwards it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness.”* Hebrews 12:4-11 (NASB)

Like a good father God allows His children to experience curses. He is not cursing us but allowing us to go through these things for our perfection. He loves us and His correction brings us to His expected end for us. (Jeremiah 29:11) God allows what we allow. When we allow disobedience, God allows the curses that come with that. When we allow nothing but obedience, God will always allow the blessings to flow freely.

GREAT REWARD COMES WITH OBEDIENCE

“The law of the Lord is perfect, restoring the [whole] person; the testimony of the Lord is sure, making wise the simple. The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure and bright, enlightening the eyes. The [reverent] fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; the ordinances of the Lord are true and righteous altogether. More to be desired are they than gold, even than much fine gold; they are sweeter also than honey and drippings from the honeycomb.

Moreover, by them is Your servant warned (reminded, illuminated, and instructed); and in keeping them there is great reward.” Psalm 19:7-11 (AMPC)

DO NOT MISUNDERSTAND ME...

I refuse to act like one of Job’s friends, therefore I want to remind you that just because you are going through a trial DOES NOT mean that you have disobeyed God. For a true believer, there is going to be true warfare when you move from one degree of glory to the next, but that is the beauty of the work of the Holy Spirit. In Acts 14 we read, “... *We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God.*” Acts 14:22 (NKJV)

It is the Holy Spirit that we need to allow to convict us of wrongdoings (not man) and let Him reveal any chaff that needs to be burned! It is the work of the Holy Spirit to help us discern whether we have opened ourselves up to a curse, or if what we are experiencing is the trying of our faith. The key is you cannot be cursed, if you are a doer of God’s Word.

In fact, Jesus said, “*Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.*” Matthew 5:10-12 (NKJV) We will be persecuted; however, this persecution will be for the sake of Jesus. When this happens, you are very blessed! There is a fine line between being cursed and being persecuted.

“*Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, **but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.** For “He who would love life And see good days, **Let him refrain his tongue from evil, And his lips***

from speaking deceit. *Let him turn away from evil and do good; Let him seek peace and pursue it. For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their prayers; But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil.”* **And who is he who will harm you if you become followers of what is good?** *But even if you should suffer* **for righteousness’ sake, you are blessed.** *“And do not be afraid of their threats, nor be troubled.”* 1 Peter 3:8-14 (NKJV)

SHOULD WE RESPOND TO THOSE WHO ATTEMPT TO CURSE US?

You should always be led by the Holy Spirit in whatever capacity He wants to lead you, however, remember what God’s Word says in Romans. *“Repay no one evil for evil, but take thought for what is honest and proper and noble [aiming to be above reproach] in the sight of everyone. If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave the way open for [God’s] wrath; for it is written, Vengeance is Mine, I will repay (requite), says the Lord. But if your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him drink; for by so doing you will heap burning coals upon his head. Do not let yourself be overcome by evil, but overcome (master) evil with good.”* Romans 12:17-21 (AMPC) All we must do as God’s children is obey God’s Word and let Him do the rest. Let God fight your battles!

Truly when the enemy attempts to curse us, we should bless them and rejoice! *“Let them curse, but do You bless. When adversaries arise, let them be put to shame, but let Your servant rejoice.”* Psalm 109:28 (NASB)

Remember, when we are living in obedience God turns any curses into blessings. **Instead of fearing curses, a man or woman of God should clearly see that as a river of blessings getting ready to flow their way!**

Paul gives us an excellent word here in Philippians, “*Only be sure as citizens so to conduct yourselves [that] your manner of life [will be] worthy of the good news (the Gospel) of Christ, so that whether I [do] come and see you or am absent, I may hear this of you: that you are standing firm in united spirit and purpose, striving side by side and contending with a single mind for the faith of the glad tidings (the Gospel). And do not [for a moment] be frightened or intimidated in anything by your opponents and adversaries, for such [constancy and fearlessness] will be a clear sign (proof and seal) to them of [their impending] destruction, but [a sure token and evidence] of your deliverance and salvation, and that from God.*” Philippians 1:27-28 (AMPC)

VENGEANCE BELONGS TO GOD

In 1 Samuel we read, “... *David and Abishai went to the army by night, and there Saul (aka their enemy) lay sleeping within the encampment with his spear stuck in the ground at his head; and Abner and the army lay round about him. Then said Abishai to David, God has given your enemy into your hands this day. Now therefore let me smite him to the earth at once with one stroke of the spear, and I will not strike him twice.*” 1 Samuel 26:7-8 (AMPC) You see, David oversaw his army and Abishai had to get permission from him to do anything. However, David knew that Saul (even though he was an enemy) was anointed of God and that vengeance belonged to God, for he replied to Abishai, “... *Do not destroy him; for who can raise his hand against the Lord’s anointed and be guiltless?* David said, *As the Lord lives, [He] will smite him; or his day will come to die or he will go down in battle and perish.*” 1 Samuel 26:9-10 (AMPC)

God desires our obedience to His Word. We are not going to speak word curses back over our enemies. We will not allow a root of gossip or bitterness to take root either. In our obedience to His Word, what happens to our enemies is in His hands. If He desires vengeance, His vengeance will happen.

However, if it is His desire to use us to show His goodness in order that our enemies may be led to repentance, then we must do our part. Isn't that what we ultimately want though, salvation for our enemies?

GOD'S ANOINTED ARE PRESERVED

Please take these scriptures to heart and ask the Holy Spirit to give you revelation concerning the preservation of His people when wicked people afflict them.

"He has remembered His covenant forever, The word which He commanded to a thousand generations, The covenant which He made with Abraham, And His oath to Isaac. Then He confirmed it to Jacob for a statute, To Israel as an everlasting covenant, Saying, "To you I will give the land of Canaan As the portion of your inheritance," When they were only a few men in number, Very few, and strangers in it. And they wandered about from nation to nation, From one kingdom to another people. He permitted no man to oppress them, And He reprov'd kings for their sakes: "Do not touch My anointed ones, And do My prophets no harm." Psalm 105:8-15 (NASB)

"The wicked plots against the just, And gnashes at him with his teeth. The Lord laughs at him, For He sees that his day is coming. The wicked have drawn the sword And have bent their bow, To cast down the poor and needy, To slay those who are of upright conduct. Their sword shall enter their own heart, And their bows shall be broken." Psalm 37:12-15 (NKJV)

Now, continuing in Psalm 37, let's move down to verse 32. *"The wicked watches the righteous, And seeks to slay him. The Lord will not leave him in his hand, Nor condemn him when he is judged."* Psalm 37:32-33 (NKJV)

WHAT IS A CURSE FROM THE ENEMY?

Remember that we wrestle not with flesh and blood, but principalities, powers and rulers of darkness. (Ephesians 6:12) From the point we ask Jesus to come into our heart, there is constant spiritual battle for our lives between light and darkness. There is a spirit that is working in the sons of disobedience that rages against God's anointed, just as it has always been.

When an opponent attempts to curse God's anointed that curse is merely a weapon formed against us. However, God's Word plainly tells us, "No weapon that is formed against you will prosper; And every tongue that accuses you in judgment you will condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, And their vindication is from Me," declares the Lord." Isaiah 54:17 (NASB)

DO WE NOT KNOW, THE LORD IS WITH US WHEREVER WE GO?

In Joshua chapter one we see that Moses had died, but God was raising up another powerful servant in his place, Joshua. Here we have what God spoke to Joshua.

"Moses My servant is dead; now therefore arise, cross this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them, to the sons of Israel. Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon, even as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and as far as the Great Sea toward the setting of the sun will be your territory. No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moses, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you. Be strong and courageous, for you shall give this people possession of the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. Only be strong and very courageous; be careful to do

according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, so that you may have success wherever you go. This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, **so that you may be careful to do according to all that is written in it;** for then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have success. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:2-9 (NASB) Dear friends, God is still raising up His leadership today in this land that He wants us to "Go and possess." Therefore, since God is not a respecter of persons, we can plainly see that we have access to the same promises God had given to Joshua!

It is going to take some boldness, strength and courage, but if our lives are founded on continuing in God's Word and being a doer of His Word there is NOTHING, but God's success laid up for us! When your life is in line with God's Word the curses of the enemy are ineffective. As God was with Moses, Joshua and many other victorious men and women of the Bible, so He is with us! Glory!

"...If God is for us, who is against us?"
Romans 8:31(NASB)

THE RIGHTEOUS/OBEDIENT CAN ONLY BE BLESSED

Psalms 119:1-2 (AMPC) "Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are the undefiled (the upright, truly sincere, and blameless) in the way [of the revealed will of God], who walk (order their conduct and conversation) in the law of the Lord (the whole of God's revealed will). Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are they who keep His testimonies, and who seek, inquire for and of Him and crave Him with the whole heart."

Proverbs 3:1-2(AMPC) *“My son, forget not my law or teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments; For length of days and years of a life [worth living] and tranquility [inward and outward and continuing through old age till death], these shall they add to you.”*

James 1:22-25 (AMPC) *“But be doers of the Word [obey the message], and not merely listeners to it, betraying yourselves [into deception by reasoning contrary to the Truth]. For if anyone only listens to the Word without obeying it and being a doer of it, he is like a man who looks carefully at his [own] natural face in a mirror; For he thoughtfully observes himself, and then goes off and promptly forgets what he was like. But he who looks carefully into the faultless law, the [law] of liberty, and is faithful to it and perseveres in looking into it, being not a heedless listener who forgets but an active doer [who obeys], he shall be blessed in his doing (his life of obedience).”*

HOW OUR OBEDIENCE WILL AFFECT US IN TRIALS

One of the seven churches that the angel comes to in the book of Revelation is the faithful church of Philadelphia, which is symbolic of the remnant of God. His prophetic words are simple yet powerful! *“And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, ‘These things says He who is holy, He who is true, ‘He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens’: ‘I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name. Indeed I will make those of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not, but lie—indeed I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you. Because you have kept My command to persevere, I also will keep you from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth.”* Revelation 3:7-10 (NKJV)

SCRIPTURAL PRAYERS/CONFESSIONS WHEN THE ENEMY COMES IN...

Father, in Jesus' name, I thank you that You have covered me with Your pinions, and under Your wings I can seek refuge. I know that Your faithfulness is a shield and buckler for me. I will not be afraid of any terror by night, or any of the arrows that fly by day, or of the pestilence that stalks in darkness, or of the destruction that lays waste at noon. A thousand may fall at my side and ten thousand at my right hand, but it shall not approach me. Psalm 91:4-7 (NASB)

Father, in the name of Jesus, I thank You that I am of You, and I have already defeated and overcome every agent of the antichrist because greater is He Who is in me than he who is in the world. 1 John 4:4

Father, in Jesus' name, I praise You for You have certainly delivered me and drawn me to Yourself from every assault of evil. You will preserve me and bring me safely unto Your heavenly kingdom. To Him be the glory forever and ever. Amen (so be it). 2 Timothy 4:18

Father, in Jesus' name, I thank You that I am built upon The Rock, and I am part of the church You have built, and the gates of Hades shall not overpower it. Matthew 16:18

Father, through You I will push back all my adversaries; through Your name I will trample down those who rise up against me. For I will not trust in my bow, nor will my sword save me. But You have saved me from my adversaries, and You have put to shame those who hate me. Psalm 44:5-7

Father, in Jesus' name, I thank You that Your Son Jesus has given to me eternal life, and I will never perish, and no one will be able to snatch me out of Jesus' hand. You are the Father, Who has

given us to Jesus, and You are greater than all, and no one is able to snatch me out of Your hand. John 10:28-29

Father, in Jesus' name, I declare that when people fight against me, they will not overcome me, for You are with me to deliver me. Jeremiah 1:19

Father, in Jesus name, I thank You that you increase Your people greatly and make us stronger than our enemies. Psalm 105:24

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“Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you.” 2 Thessalonians 3:1

“So mightily grew the word of God and prevailed.” Acts 19:20

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
