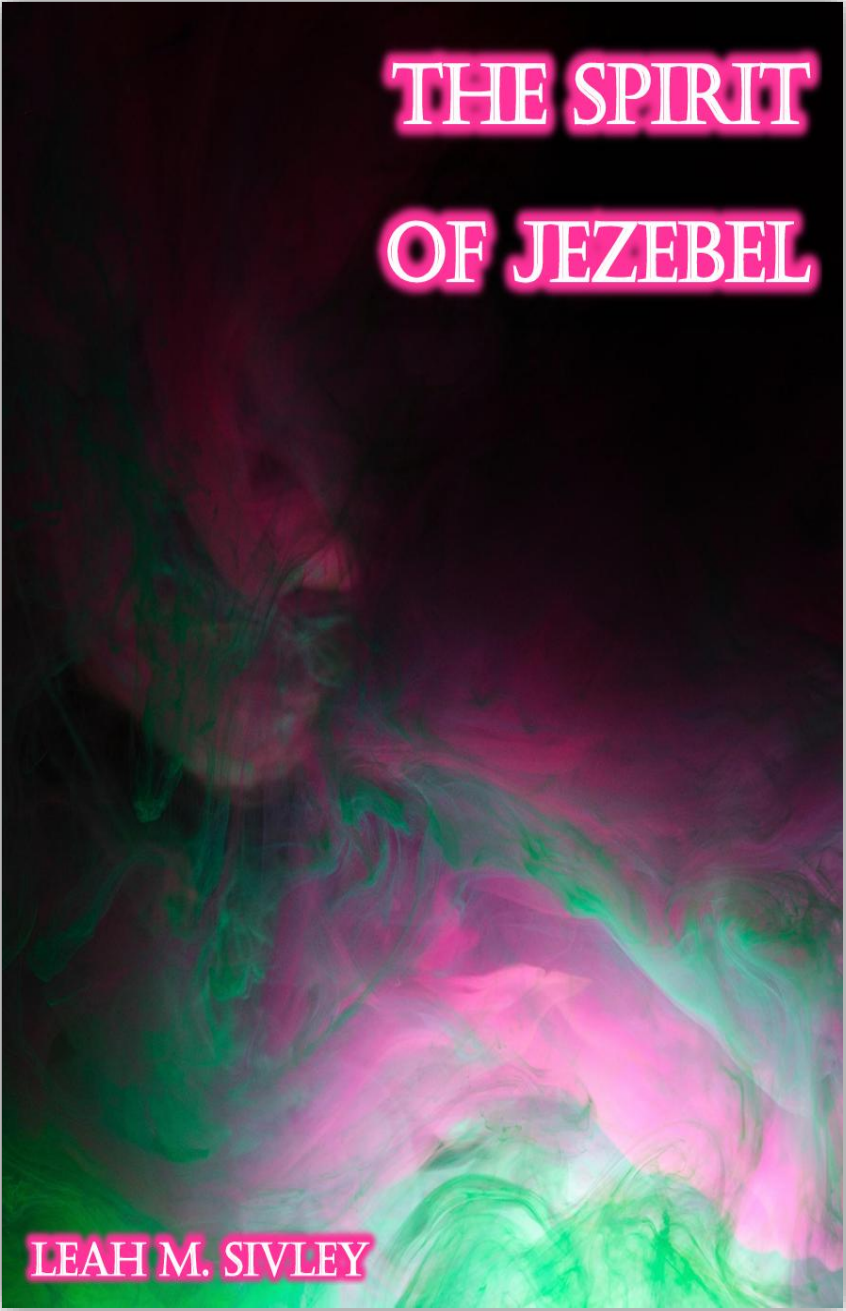




THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this teaching is to bring awareness to something God clearly hates according to His Word. I emphasize “according to His Word” because many ministries have presented traits, behaviors, and personal claims about this spirit without providing Scripture to support what they teach. Prevailing Word Publishing is committed to honoring the integrity of God’s Word by presenting only information that can be supported through rightly divided Scripture.

Other ministries may offer additional points or their own interpretations on this topic, but I encourage you, as a student of the Bible and a disciple of Jesus, to ensure that every teaching, song, or ministry you receive is firmly grounded in God’s truth.

Many Christians are ignorant of this topic, and it has caused unnecessary church splits, and great hardship because they were not properly equipped with the necessary knowledge. I do not wish you to take my word on this; however, I do urge you to go back and study this for yourselves, pray, and receive all the truth that is found in the scriptures. Remember the Bereans were more noble than those in Thessalonica in that they searched the scriptures daily to see if these things be so. (Acts 17:11)

Do not be of those who reject His rightly divided truth. Hosea 4:6 (NASB) *“My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being My priest. Since you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.”*

REBUKE TO THE CHURCH IN THYATIRA:

Revelation 2:19-28 (NASB) *“¹⁹ I know your deeds, and your love and faith and service and perseverance, and that your deeds of late are greater than at first. ²⁰ But I have this against you, that you tolerate the*

woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray so that they commit acts of immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. ²¹ I gave her time to repent, and she does not want to repent of her immorality. ²² Behold, I will throw her on a bed of sickness, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds. ²³ And I will kill her children with pestilence, and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your deeds. ²⁴ But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them—I place no other burden on you. ²⁵ Nevertheless what you have, hold fast until I come. ²⁶ He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, to him I will give authority over the nations; ²⁷ and he shall rule them with a rod of iron, as the vessels of the potter are broken to pieces, as I also have received authority from My Father; ²⁸ and I will give him the morning star. ²⁹ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.”

WHY ISN'T THIS BEING TAUGHT IN THE CHURCHES?

If you know about the Spirit of Jezebel, did you gain your knowledge of Jezebel from the church? Remember in Revelation 2:24 (NASB) “But I say to you, the rest who are in Thyatira, who do not hold this teaching, who have not known the deep things of Satan, as they call them—” Friends, Satan couldn’t beat the church so, he had to join it. If you are in a place that refuses to speak on the spirit of Jezebel, this could be a “red flag” to get out. Mark 3:24-26 (NASB) “²⁴ If a kingdom is divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. ²⁵ If a house is divided against itself, that house will not be able to stand. ²⁶ If Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished!” If Jezebel exposed herself, then her kingdom would be finished. Some people, possessed by the spirit of Jezebel, will “teach” on this spirit, falsely accusing people (even by name) of having a Jezebel spirit.

Not all people with a Jezebel spirit teach, but those who do are seasoned at it. They know just enough truth to manipulate those who do not know truth. THAT IS WHY IT IS SO IMPORTANT TO KNOW A RIGHTLY-DIVIDED TRUTH.

Remember the garden of Eden when Satan first came to Eve? How did he deceive her?

Go back and compare what God told Adam in Genesis 2:16-17 to the conversation between the serpent and Eve in Genesis 3:1-5. We see that Satan twisted the words spoken to Eve and confused her into believing a lie. Remember 1 Corinthians 14:33 (NASB) says *“for God is not a God of confusion but of peace...”* In James 3:16 NKJV it reads, *“¹⁶For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there.”* If you are a new believer and you do not know truth, you can expect to be a little confused in the beginning. However, the more you grow in rightly dividing the word of truth, you will find, when something comes in and brings with it confusion, those things are not of God, no matter how spiritual or sensual they may feel.

ANOTHER JESUS, ANOTHER GOSPEL AND A DIFFERENT SPIRIT

In Colossians 2:6-10 (NASB) we read, *“⁶Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, **so walk in Him**, ⁷having been firmly rooted and now being built up in Him and established in your faith, just as you were instructed, and overflowing with gratitude.”*

The first step to walking in Jesus, after receiving Him, is to know Him. Who is this Jesus? Yes, He holds many titles including the Son of God, the Way, the Truth and the Life, The Light of the World, and many more. Jesus is also the Word of God. *“¹⁴And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.”* John 1:14 (NASB)

Concerning Jesus in Revelation 19:13 (NASB) it is written, *"¹³ He is clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God."* Therefore, to walk in Jesus, we must know God's Word.

Continuing in Colossians 2 verse 8 we read, *"⁸ See to it that no one takes you captive through philosophy and empty deception, according to the tradition of men, according to the elementary principles of the world, rather than according to Christ. ⁹ For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form, ¹⁰ and in Him you have been made complete, and He is the head over all rule and authority;"* Colossians 2:8-10 (NASB) When the Word of God plainly tells us to see to it that no one takes us captive through these various tactics listed, this is not a suggestion friend, it is a command.

Here is the core of why deception is so dangerous. Paul explains in his letters in 2 Corinthians 11:3-4 (NASB) *"³ But **I am afraid...**"* (Pay attention to what his fear was, because Paul was full of boldness, but not fear.) *"... that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ. ⁴ For if one comes and preaches another Jesus whom we have not preached, or you receive a different spirit which you have not received, or a different gospel which you have not accepted, you bear this beautifully."*

This passage has rattled me for years, but it makes perfect sense. There are organizations that teach of a Jesus that cannot heal or protect you. There are preachers that open you up to a spirit, other than the Holy Spirit. These things take place because, though they may be using the same Bible, it has not been rightly divided. Whole congregations are being led astray due to this. Jesus told His disciples, concerning the Pharisees, *"Let them alone; they are blind guides of the blind. And if a blind man guides a blind man, both will fall into a pit."* Matthew 15:14 (NASB)

Friend, God does not want us in a pit, but it will take some effort of your part. I cannot stress this enough, you need to study to show yourself approved. (2 Timothy 2:15)

THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL REPRESENTS EVERYTHING GOD HATES

It is clearly defined here in Proverbs what the Lord hates.

*“There are six things which the Lord hates, Yes, seven which are an abomination to Him: ¹⁷ **Haughty eyes, a lying tongue, And hands that shed innocent blood,** ¹⁸ **A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that run rapidly to evil,** ¹⁹ **A false witness who utters lies, And one who spreads strife among brothers.**” Proverbs 6:16-20 (NASB)*

In 1 Kings 21 we read that it was Jezebel who was at the root of killing Naboth for his property. Please note I have placed in bold how all her actions in this matter possessed everything that God hates accord to the passage above in Proverbs. It was Jezebel who:

- Reminded Ahab of his controlling power as king over Israel and convinced Ahab that he did not have to accept Naboth's refusal to sell his property. (**Haughty Eyes**)~Haughty is Strong's #7311-bring up, exalt self, extol, give, go up, haughty, heave up, be)
- Forged letters in Ahab's name and sealed them with his seal using his power as king. (**A lying tongue**)
- Sent those letters to the elders, and nobles who were living with Naboth in his city. Jezebel knew she had to act quickly, to waste no time in her agenda she purposely sought after the approval of those in control of the people. The letters had specific instructions for the people to proclaim a fast, and seat Naboth at the head of the people. (**We see three evil characteristics here. A heart that devises wicked plans and feet that run rapidly to evil and a false witness who spreads strife among brethren.**)

- Also advised in the letters that the elders and nobles were to seat two worthless men willing to falsely prophesy against the man of God Naboth and accuse him of cursing God and the king. (**Again, we see false witnesses who utter lies.**)
- Ultimately killed Naboth by persuading others (by the power of Ahab, the elders and nobles) to have Naboth stoned. (**Hands that shed innocent blood.**)

Jezebel could not have done a better job at the completion of all seven abominations that God hates. Friends, nothing has changed today. The spirit of Jezebel continues to work in this manner. By this we can conclude that the spirit of Jezebel deals with the deep things of Satan.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO TOLERATE THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL?

In Revelation 2:20 the word tolerate is the Greek word *aphiémi* (#863) and is defined as to send away, to leave, to forgive, to permit, to abandon. Since the first usage of a word in the Bible holds the bulk of its true meaning, let's look at the very first usage of this word *aphiémi* which is found in Matthew.

The context here is when John the Baptist was baptizing people and Jesus came up to him to be baptized. Initially John was not willing to baptize Jesus, and this was what came forth next. (The bold words are the usage of the Greek word *aphiémi*) ¹⁵ *But Jesus answering said to him, “**Permit** it at this time; for in this way it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness.” Then he **permitted** Him.”* Matthew 3:15 (NASB)

Therefore, we see more clearly that this means to allow something to happen. The Strong's exhaustive concordance further defines this as “forsake, lay aside, leave, let (alone, be, go, have), omit, put (send) away, remit, suffer, yield up.”

Many churches have been passive in allowing (or tolerating) the spirit of Jezebel and justify it as the fruits of the Holy Spirit in operation in them. However, if Jezebel represents everything that God hates, then is the continuation of its allowance as a form of love really the love of God? It is not.

THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL

Let it be known that though Jezebel was an actual person in the Bible, what we are now dealing with is the spirit of Jezebel. The spirit of Jezebel can manifest through a man or a woman. Let us be reminded of what Jesus said to His disciples describing what a spirit is, after He was resurrected from the dead in Luke 24:37-39 (NASB) ***“³⁷ But they were startled and frightened **and thought that they were seeing a spirit.** ³⁸ And He said to them, “Why are you troubled, and why do doubts arise in your hearts? ³⁹ See My hands and My feet, that it is I Myself; touch Me and see, for **a spirit does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have.**”*** Therefore, we see that a spirit is not gender specific. The only thing the Jezebel spirit needs is a host that will tolerate her presence whether that host be a male or female.

Hence for the believer, we have this instruction in Ephesians 6:12 (NASB) ***“¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places.”***

How do we fight spirits? We must fight spirits the same way that Jesus did with Satan in the wilderness. Jesus taught us to speak the word of God against Satan.

CHARACTERISTICS OF THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL

1. NO TRUE REPENTANCE BUT EXCESSIVE EMPTY APOLOGIES

A spirit of Jezebel will often “apologize” in a manner like this: “I’m sorry if there is anything that I have done to offend you or hurt you, please forgive me.” Or, “I’m sorry if you have misunderstood me.” There is no actual confession of wrongdoing.

Sometimes the spirit of Jezebel will even accompany this “apology” with fake tears/emotions, or even to the point of not eating just like Ahab did when Naboth told him that he would not sell his inheritance to him. (1 Kings 21:4)

It has been my personal experience that a person with the spirit of Jezebel will “apologize” in this matter, however, there is no change in their life. Remember in dealing with a true spirit of Jezebel, there is no repentance.

A true man or woman of God that is battling with behavior like this will confess and repent, because they are doers of His word.

Here are just a few scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

“He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who confesses and forsakes them will find compassion.” Proverbs 28:13 (NASB)

“Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.” James 5:16 (NASB)

“If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” 1 John 1:9 (NASB)

2 . CONFUSION IN ALL SPEECH

It is impossible to converse with a Jezebel spirit in logic. They may keep conversation so vague, or just talk in circles with so much information, but no one who is truly paying attention will be without confusion. This is another way to maintain control and dominate. When confronting a Jezebel spirit, the subject may be changed five times in one minute. Confusion keeps them unexposed.

Here are just a few scriptures to help you discern yourself.

1 Corinthians 14:32-33 (NASB) *"³²and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets; ³³for God is not a God of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints."* Yes, in context this scripture is about prophecy, but what drives prophecy? Prophecy, true or false, is initiated by a spirit.

James 3:16 (NKJV) *"¹⁶For where envy and self-seeking exist, confusion and every evil thing are there."*

3. CRITICAL OF EVERYONE

Remember Jezebel loves to dominate, therefore if an idea or plan does not originate from them it will never be good enough. They must be the only one who looks good; therefore, they will quickly criticize anyone who makes a suggestion or plan.

Here are just a few scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

Matthew 7:1-5 (AMPC) *"Do not judge and criticize and condemn others, so that you may not be judged and criticized and condemned yourselves. ²For just as you judge and criticize and condemn others, you will be judged and criticized and condemned, and in accordance with the measure you [use to] deal out to others, it will be dealt out again to you. ³Why do you stare from without at the very small particle that is in your brother's eye but do not become aware of and consider the beam of timber that is in your*

own eye? ⁴Or how can you say to your brother, Let me get the tiny particle out of your eye, when there is the beam of timber in your own eye? ⁵You hypocrite, first get the beam of timber out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the tiny particle out of your brother's eye."

Ephesians 4:29 (AMPC) *"²⁹ Let no foul or polluting language, nor evil word nor unwholesome or worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, **but only such [speech] as is good and beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need and the occasion, that it may be a blessing and give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it.**"*

4. HAS TO ONE-UP OTHERS

A person with a Jezebel spirit will always upstage other people. They feel threatened (or maybe insecure) by anyone who dares to "steal the stage" or really anyone who they see is a threat to their power and control. If you are with such a person and tell of your accomplishments, victories, or even a praise report you can be assured they will have "something better."

Here are just a few scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

Philippians 2:3-5 (AMPC) *"³Do nothing from factional motives [through contentiousness, strife, selfishness, or for unworthy ends] or prompted by conceit and empty arrogance. **Instead, in the true spirit of humility (lowliness of mind) let each regard the others as better than and superior to himself [thinking more highly of one another than you do of yourselves]** ⁴**Let each of you esteem and look upon and be concerned for not [merely] his own interests, but also each for the interests of others.** ⁵**Let this same attitude and purpose and [humble] mind be in you which was in Christ Jesus: [Let Him be your example in humility:]**"*

Proverbs 27:2 (NASB) *"Let another praise you, **and not your own mouth**; A stranger, **and not your own lips.**"*

Please do not misunderstand me, we should want to boast on what God is doing in our lives, and brag on Him. However, it should never come at the cost of someone else's humiliation. The true circumcision of the body of Christ genuinely loves to hear what God is doing in each one's lives.

Romans 12:15 (NASB) ***"Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep."***

1 Corinthians 12:26 (NASB) ***"²⁶And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if one member is honored, all the members rejoice with it."***

5. SEIZES AND USES INFORMATION

This spirit always wants to be the first to know and control important information. (This is why the internet has become such a useful tool for the spirit of Jezebel.) They seem to know everything about people's lives and actions in mass quantities.

In my personal experience, when my husband went to be with the Lord, I was trying to sell things I no longer needed and knowing that Facebook Marketplace was a perfect place to list to locals, I finally created a Facebook account. To my surprise, (but not really) I received "Friend Requests" from two different people that to my knowledge do not know each other, and in fact are in different states miles apart. Both people I know by the Spirit of God are under the control of a spirit of Jezebel. A Jezebel spirit uses information as a leverage for power and then shares tidbits with you, or others. This can, at times, be things told to them in confidence. This gives them a sense of power, even to the point of trying to impress people by "knowing things" that others do not.

Friend, if certain people are not in your contacts as those whom you could text or call, why in the world would you want them to know personal information about you?

Here is a scripture to help you discern for yourself.

Matthew 7:6 (AMPC) *“Do not give that which is holy (the sacred thing) to the dogs, and do not throw your pearls before hogs, lest they trample upon them with their feet and turn and tear you in pieces.”*

A nugget of wisdom here, if you are actively working in front line ministry, **it is wisdom not to put your personal life online**. Yes, there is already a lot they can find online, but you do not have to aid them in this.

James 1:27 (AMPC) *“²⁷ External religious worship [religion as it is expressed in outward acts] that is pure and unblemished in the sight of God the Father is this: to visit and help and care for the orphans and widows in their affliction and need, **and to keep oneself unspotted and uncontaminated from the world.**”*

You might be very surprised to know what this spirit can do with just a little personal truth.

6. INCESSANTLY CHATTERING

Many people talk habitually, but a Jezebel uses incessant chatter as a form of control. In a typical conversation, they usually do all the talking, no matter what the topic is, **and it can even be concerning God**. This is a form of control; they are unable to receive input from anyone else. **You are doing the listening, and all conversation is one-sided.**

Here are just a few scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

Proverbs 10:19 (NASB) **“When there are many words, transgression is unavoidable,** *But he who restrains his lips is wise.”*

Proverbs 17:27-28 (NASB) **“He who restrains his words has knowledge,** *And he who has a cool spirit is a man of understanding.*
²⁸ Even a fool, when he keeps silent, is considered wise; When he closes his lips, he is considered prudent.”

7. FINDS SPIRITUAL MEANING IN EVERYTHING CONCERNING YOUR LIFE... AND THEIRS

Please do not get me wrong, we should have “spiritual eyes” and be “walking by faith not by sight” however, when a Jezebel spirit is attempting to dominate and manipulate you to doing what “they” want you to do, they will explain it to you in a way where everything about it is “spiritual.” They will use something in the natural in your life and try to “prove” that you are not in the will of God. (A good example would be Job’s friends.) This will be in a way that if you do not understand them, it is “above” your understanding... like they are superior because they understand this realm of the spirit, and you do not.

For example, if you have an argument with them, in their manipulation, they may say something like this, “I noticed you were eating green peas the other day, and I knew something was off in the realm of the spirit. That’s when I think you let this spirit in.” Their reasoning will not be scriptural at all. On the flip side, they may try to twist or use scripture to support their agenda just as Satan did in the garden with Eve.

However, if this spirit does something out of the will of God and against His word, (Remember, Satan knows the word of God.) they will try to spiritualize it away to support their actions. It may go something like this, “I know what I said to so-and so was not entirely true, but when I was telling them, I remembered I had seen a dove that morning, and the Holy Spirit told me that if I told the whole truth they would be offended.”

This prevents them from any accountability of repentance or what is required of them. Remember Jezebel is non-repentant, and does not do the will of God, but will always explain this “spiritually” in a way you are not meant to understand.

Here is a scripture to help you discern for yourself.

1 John 4:1 (NASB) *“Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits to see whether they are from God, because many false prophets have gone out into the world.”*

The realm of the Spirit of God can seem challenging at times but never forget this: **THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL NEVER PROMPT YOU, OR ANYONE ELSE, TO DO SOMETHING THAT IS CONTRARY TO THE WORD OF GOD. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF A TRUE BELIEVER TO DISCERN ACCORDING TO THE WORD OF GOD.**

8. IS INSUBORDINATE AND RARELY GIVES ANYONE CREDIT OR SHOWS GRATITUDE TO A GODLY PERSON

A Jezebel spirit will rarely acknowledge a godly person's actions. They just cannot bring themselves to say thank you for their service, or acknowledge that someone else did something right. This again puts the controller in a position of power.

Here is a scripture to help you discern for yourself.

Proverbs 3:27 (NASB) *“Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, When it is in your power to do it.”*

This being said, any godly person is not going to be “moved” by flattering lips. Being a “front-line” minister of the gospel can be very weary at times of full force warfare, and a word of encouragement or credit for their ministry can help keep them going on. Then again, the spirit of Jezebel does not want them to keep them going on. Remember, in the Bible Jezebel's agenda was to kill the prophets of God.

The spirit of Jezebel uses lip service, but only when it benefits them.

A Jezebel never takes the side of a godly person in authority, **unless it is a temporary action to make themselves look good.** They often will take credit for someone else's idea. Their main desire

is power and control. There is no conscience when an opportunity for recognition presents itself.

Galatians 6:10 (NASB) ***“¹⁰ So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.”***

Paul had no problem exalting other godly men and women of God in his letters. See the letters Paul wrote concerning the man of God Titus (2 Corinthians 8:16-24) Timothy and Epaphroditus (Philippians 2:19-30), and great number of the others in ministry with him. (Romans 16:1-16)

9. CONTROLS BY INSTILLING FEAR

Elijah had pronounced a drought on the land for 3 years and 6 months. (1 Kings 17:1; James 5:17) During this time we know that Jezebel was killing the prophets of God. So she and Ahab were obviously looking for Elijah, but God was protecting him. (1 Kings 18:4) The drought did not break until after Elijah killed the 400 prophets of Baal. (1 Kings 18:40-45) Yet, despite all of this when Jezebel gave death threats to Elijah, he was driven a day's journey into the wilderness and sat under a juniper tree and prayed to die. (1 Kings 19:1-4) An angel came and fed him then he fasted for 40 days (40 being probation) and he still, after all of that, ended up in a cave still in fear of Jezebel's threats.

God did not answer Elijah's prayer requests to die, because according to the thoughts and plans God had for Elijah he was never meant to die!

We know that 2 Timothy 1:7 (NASB) says, *“For God has not given us a spirit of timidity, but of power and love and discipline.”*

Here is another good one to help you discern! 1 John 4:18 (NASB) *“There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love.”*

The Holy Spirit will never cause you to be fearful.

10. IS CLAIRVOYANT (AKA a familiar spirit, ESP, like unto a psychic or extrasensory perception) is a claimed ability to acquire information beyond the five traditional senses, often referred to as a "sixth sense."

Many who operate with a spirit of control also have a clairvoyant spirit. A Jezebel spirit can have a supernatural help in knowing and sensing information. If they use this against you, they may say "I can't tell you how I know this. I just know it." This is not the Holy Spirit, but the help of a familiar spirit.

I am going to take a little more time on this one because it is a big one for those "church goers" who desire the gifts of the spirit in operation. This was huge for me because I grew up in an area that thrived on prophecy, in accordance with 1 Thessalonians 5:19-20 (NASB) *"Do not quench the Spirit; do not despise prophetic utterances."* Years ago in dealing with this God revealed to me that you must keep reading the next two verses: ***"But examine everything carefully: hold fast to that which is good; abstain from every form of evil."*** 1 Thessalonians 5:21-22 (NASB) The Holy Spirit will reveal what is going to bring glory to the Lord, and it will be scriptural. If it is not, then do not let it defile you!

I cannot stress this enough, like I said earlier under heading number seven, you should discern every spirit with the word of God. (1 John 4:1 NASB)

Consider this next conversation between Joram (the son of Jezebel) and Jehu.

2 Kings 9:22 (NASB) *"When Joram saw Jehu, he said, 'Is it peace, Jehu?'" And he answered, "What peace, so long as the harlotries of your mother Jezebel and her witchcrafts are so many?"*

This word *witchcrafts* in the Hebrew is #3785 and it literally means sorcery, witchcraft, and magic.

I have seen good men and women of God get filled with the baptism of the Holy Spirit for real, but then they do not continue in the Word of God. Instead, being enticed by a bunch of hype, they listen to non-scriptural teachings, and nonsense. As a result, they now are susceptible to operating under familiar spirits. What they know in carnality can be true, but it will not be advancing the kingdom of God or bringing glory to God. It is no different than psychic abilities.

For years I passed by a psychic place of business in southern Utah and as an advertisement on the sign outside of their offices they had the passage John 3:16. They would not have had this scripture on their sign if it was not working. I mean it was there for years. So, who do you think their clientele was? It was Christians! As a believer that was a scary sight for me! Specifically, it was Christians who didn't know their Bible. Christians who did not know that as a Christian it is the Holy Spirit's responsibility to lead them and guide them into all truth and show them things to come. (John 16:13)

Remember in Revelation 2:20 it says, Jezebel calls herself a prophetess, and she teaches and leads His bondservants astray so that they commit acts of immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols. Having these extrasensory perceptions, which are not of the Holy Spirit, are exactly how she takes advantage of those who seek things of the supernatural, spiritual realm. In 1 Corinthians 1:22 it says that the Jews sought after signs. This is exactly how people fall prey to Jezebel, by looking after signs. Don't get me wrong, true signs are amazing, but Jesus told us, *"... signs will accompany those who have believed."* Mark 16:17 (NASB) Therefore instead of chasing signs, we need to examine the root of the ministry. We should run from any ministry that falls short of continuing in a rightly divided word of God.

11. ATTEMPTS TO MAKE YOU LOOK LIKE YOU ARE THE BAD GUY, OR INSINUATES IT IS YOU THAT HAS THE SPIRIT OF JEZEBEL.

Pay attention to what Elijah told Ahab, here in 1 Kings 17:1 (NASB) *“Now Elijah the Tishbite, who was of the settlers of Gilead, said to Ahab, “As the Lord, the God of Israel lives, before whom I stand, surely there shall be neither dew nor rain these years, except by my word.”*

Now, as we will see three years passes upon the beginning of chapter 18, then we read of what God commanded Elijah to tell Ahab. *“Now it happened after many days that the word of the LORD came to Elijah in the third year, saying, “Go, present yourself to Ahab, and I will provide rain on the face of the earth.”* 1 Kings 18:1 (NASB) Thus, we are reminded clearly that it was God working through Elijah, to bring this drought which caused the severe famine in the land and led to the drought. Elijah did nothing in himself.

However, dropping down to verse 17 when Ahab finally addresses Elijah, we see that Ahab turned things around and accused Elijah of being the bad guy. *“¹⁷ When Ahab saw Elijah, **Ahab said to him, “Is this you, the cause of disaster to Israel?”**”* 1 Kings 18:17 (NASB)

Do we see this? Elijah was coming back to Ahab to allow God to provide the rain again! The drought was an act of righteousness. Now let's see how Elijah responds to that comment in verse 18. *“¹⁸ He said, **“I have not brought disaster to Israel, but you and your father's house have, because you have abandoned the commandments of the LORD and you have followed the Baals.”**”* 1 Kings 18:18 (NASB) It was Ahab and Jezebel's rebellion that provoked God to shut up the heavens.

In the case of Naboth's vineyard in the letters that Jezebel sent, the accusation against Naboth was that he *“...cursed God and the king.”* 1 Kings 21:10 (NASB) However, Naboth was a man of God. (Not much is said about Naboth's relationship with God, however by his refusal to

sell his father's inheritance he was following the religious law of his day according to Leviticus 25:23–28)

Sometimes, a Jezebel spirit can be difficult to identify. As we see with Ahab when confrontation draws near, he skillfully distorted the situation to make Elijah appear controlling. The spirit of Jezebel will do whatever it can to be justified.

God's word clearly states, *"Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; Who substitute darkness for light and light for darkness; Who substitute bitter for sweet and sweet for bitter! Woe to those who are wise in their own eyes And clever in their own sight!"* Isaiah 5:20-21 (NASB)

How does God feel about Ahab's accusation of Elijah according to scriptures? *"One who justifies the wicked **and one who condemns the righteous. Both of them alike are an abomination to the Lord.**"* Proverbs 17:5 (NASB)

Now, let's see if Elijah was acting righteously or not, according to scripture. *"²⁴**He who says to the wicked, You are righteous and innocent**—peoples will curse him, nations will defy and abhor him. ²⁵**But to those [upright judges] who rebuke the wicked, it will go well with them and they will find delight, and a good blessing will be upon them.**"* Proverbs 24:24-25 (AMPC)

Consider this, the religious spirits (the Pharisees and Sadducees) acted this way toward Jesus, so if you are in ministry, at some point you **will** be treated in this manner.

One of my previous mentors went to a class teaching on the spirit of Jezebel. At the beginning of the class the teacher walks in and tells the whole class that, "Only people with the spirit of Jezebel take my class."

My mentor began praying and asking God to give him revelation of what was going on, because after searching his heart, he

did not discern he was possessed with this spirit. The Holy Spirit told my mentor plainly, “The Spirit of Jezebel is leading this class.”

12. GIFT GIVING

Gift giving is a form of manipulation a Jezebel spirit uses to silently persuade people who are naïve to the realm of the spirit, in order that they will feel obligated to them. In Proverbs, Solomon gives us a warning about this situation. “Many will seek the favor of a generous man, And every man is a friend to him who gives gifts.” Proverbs 19:6 (NASB)

However, gifts from the spirit of Jezebel are not the gifts of a cheerful giver. No matter what the gift is, or the size of the gift, any gifts from a Jezebel spirit will come with unspoken expectations. **Remember Jezebel fed 450 prophets of Baal, and 400 prophets of the Asherah.** (1 Kings 18:19) Some people just read over this, but you must remember that God had just used Elijah to pronounce a drought in 1 Kings 17:1, and that caused a famine in the land. It did not begin to rain until AFTER the encounter on Mount Carmel when God caused fire to fall from heaven, and the prophets of Baal were slain. (1 Kings 18:36-46)

Therefore, the significance of Jezebel feeding these “prophets” becomes more clear. Her food was a “gift” to the prophets of Baal and Asherah. It is likely, as Revelation 2:20 expresses, that this food had even been sacrificed to idols. We cannot go outside of what we know from scriptures but let’s look again at the warning in Revelation 2:20 (NASB) “²⁰ But I have this against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, **and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray so that they commit sexual immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.**”

The spirit of Jezebel teaches and leads God’s bondservants astray. These guys could have been phenomenal prophets for God, **however they were not looking to God to supply their needs,**

during the famine like Elijah did. Instead, they were enticed to receive her “gifts” of food in their desperation of the famine.

Again, please do not get me wrong, it is good to give gifts when you are prompted by the Lord. Paul said in Acts 20:35 (NASB) “... *remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He Himself said, ‘**It is more blessed to give than to receive.**’*”

If you are motivated by the Holy Spirit and you are a cheerful giver, you should not give this one a second thought. God knows your heart. I love to give in whatever capacity the Holy Spirit directs!

Psalms 37:21 (NASB) “*The wicked borrows and does not pay back, **But the righteous is gracious and gives.***”

2 Corinthians 9:7 (NASB) “*Each one must do just as he has purposed in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, **for God loves a cheerful giver.***”

13. USES PEOPLE TO ACCOMPLISH ITS AGENDA

I strategically placed this characteristic here after “gift giving” as it goes hand in hand with it. The Jezebel spirit lets others do its dirty work. Think about the battle between God and false religion that happened on Mount Carmel. When it came time for Elijah to challenge Baal through the 450 false prophets, Jezebel was missing in action.

Oh, did these prophets cry out to Baal, though Baal’s voice was not heard. Oh, did these prophets even cut themselves to the point that blood gushed out, yet Baal was silent. These were the very ones who were fed at Jezebel’s table, but where was the help of Jezebel now? She provided their need for food in the famine, but why did she not come and assist them now? (1 Kings 18:20-29)

The Jezebel spirit often stirs up another person’s emotions and then allows that person to erupt in anger. Meanwhile, it remains in the background, appearing innocent and saying, “Who, me? What

did I do?" This tactic makes the spirit difficult to identify, even for sincere seekers of truth, because it conceals its influence behind the reactions of others.

In the end all 450 prophets of Baal were killed at the battle on Mount Carmel, and yet Jezebel did nothing to help those false prophets that she was feeding and manipulating to advance her agenda.

In speaking of Jezebel Revelation 2:22 (NASB) says, *"Behold, I will throw her on a bed of sickness, and those who commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of her deeds."* These prophets fell into a great tribulation that ended in death.

God's word says, *"Cursed is the man who trusts in mankind And makes flesh his strength, And whose heart turns away from the Lord. ⁶For he will be like a bush in the desert, And will not see when prosperity comes, But will live in stony wastes in the wilderness, A land of salt that is not inhabited. ⁷Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, And whose trust is the Lord. ⁸For he will be like a tree planted by the water That extends its roots by a stream, And does not fear when the heat comes; But its leaves will be green, And it will not be anxious in a year of drought, Nor cease to yield fruit."* Jeremiah 17:5-8 (NASB)

A couple more examples of Jezebel using others to advance her agenda were in the case of Naboth she used:

1. Ahab (his seal to write the letters),
2. the elders and leaders, (because she needed their ruling),
3. and two false witnesses to testify against Naboth. (1 Kings 21:8-10)

I urge you, child of God, **if you consistently trust the Lord to supply all your needs, you will not fall prey to being used by a spirit of Jezebel.** God wants to bless you, and He will continue to bless you when your trust is completely in Him. It is not to say that those blessings will not come in the form of a gift from someone. It is a blessing to receive gifts from men and women being used by God.

The final point I want to make is to always trust in the Lord. During this famine the false prophets, and the true prophet Elijah both had a free-will choice, and this choice was based on their heart and their level of faith in God. Elijah chose to trust God and during the famine God provided ravens to bring him food, a brook for water, and even when the brook dried up God sent him to a widow to feed him. Then even after Jezebel threatened to kill him God provided an angel to feed him. However, these prophets of Baal trusted in Jezebel and ate her food. Baal's prophets died, and Elijah never saw death. Glory to God!

Here are some scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

"The fear of man brings a snare, But one who trusts in the Lord will be protected." Proverbs 25:29 (NASB)

*"The rich rules over the poor, **And the borrow becomes the lender's slave.**"* Proverbs 22:7 (NASB)

14. IS RUTHLESS

Remember, the Jezebel spirit refuses repentance or correction and is not open to accepting responsibility. When dealing with this spirit, contradiction or confrontation often turns the person confronting it into an enemy.

If there is an agreement, everything may appear peaceful, but once this spirit is challenged, it often responds with hostility, accusation, and retaliation. Its fierce attacks are often aimed at destroying the reputation and credibility of the one who exposed it.

Remember, Elijah was in the will of God in destroying the prophets of Baal that Jezebel was feeding, however, Jezebel was dedicated to have him killed after her darkness was exposed and her Kingdom was defeated (1 Kings 19: 1-2). The kingdom of Jezebel has not changed; It is strategically designed to keep people in bondage.

15. DEMANDS ATTENTION AND CREATES DRAMA

A Jezebel likes to be the center of attention and doesn't like to see others recognized and lauded. 2 Kings 9:30 (AMPC) *"³⁰ Now when Jehu came to Jezreel, Jezebel heard of it, and she painted her eyes and beautified her head and looked out of [an upper] window."* Jezebel got some unwanted attention that day!

16. RELIGIOUS IN NATURE

Jezebel was religious, even though it was a false religion. We read this about Jezebel's husband Ahab in 1 Kings 16:31 (NASB) *"³¹ And as though it had been a trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, he married Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, and went and served Baal, and worshiped him."* We see that the sins of Ahab went from bad to worse here. First, he was walking in the sins of Jeroboam, but when he married Jezebel he went into greater darkness, **for when he became one with her, Ahab also became one with her god Baal.**

The spirit of Jezebel likewise attempts to dwell in local churches. We can see all the traits of Jezebel right here in 2 Timothy and it is connected with a warning of how the last days will be.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 (NASB) *"But realize this, that in the last days difficult times will come. ² For men will be lovers of self, lovers of money, boastful, arrogant, revilers, disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy, ³ unloving, irreconcilable, malicious gossips, without self-control, brutal, haters of good, ⁴ treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ holding to a form of godliness, although they have denied its power; Avoid such men as these."* Like Jezebel, these groups will have a form of godliness! Sure, the Bible tells us to love people, and these people will appear religious, but it also tells us specifically to avoid people that have these types of spirits.

17. IS CONDESCENDING

A Jezebel spirit pressures people to act according to its will, often making them feel as though they have no right to think, choose, or make decisions for themselves. It speaks and behaves in a condescending way, belittling others as though they lack the wisdom or ability to discern rightly on their own. This spirit may twist scriptures to benefit their own agendas.

Here is a scripture to help give you some insight to discern for yourself.

"...our beloved brother Paul, according to the wisdom given him, wrote to you,¹⁶ as also in all his letters, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which the untaught and unstable distort, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures, to their own destruction." 2 Peter 3:16 (NASB)

Think about this, Ahab was a king, and when Naboth refused to sell his vineyard to him (which was Naboth's inheritance) Ahab never asked Jezebel for advice, she provided it herself by stating, *"Do you now reign over Israel?"* This question was followed up by, *"... Arise, eat bread, and let your heart be joyful; I will give you the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite."* 1 Kings 21:7 (NASB) We see how this whole situation was condescending to Ahab as being king. She treated him as if he were inferior, and a coward and the only way to advance the agenda was to do it "her way." (1 Kings 21:7-10)

Now, just for a moment, think about Queen Esther and how she treated her husband King Ahasuerus in comparison to how Queen Jezebel treated King Ahab.

18. OPERATES WITH A PRIDEFUL KNOW-IT-ALL MENTALITY

This one kind of goes hand in hand with number 17. A Jezebel spirit often displays pride through an exaggerated confidence in its own knowledge and opinions. It is quick to speak, quick to

correct, and quick to make its viewpoint known, as though its perspective is always superior. Those opinions can even become idols, valued above humility, truth, and the true counsel of God's Word.

Here are some scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

James 4:6 (AMPC) *"6 But He gives us more and more grace (power of the Holy Spirit, to meet this evil tendency and all others fully). That is why He says, God sets Himself against the proud and haughty, but gives grace [continually] to the lowly (those who are humble enough to receive it)."*

Proverbs 15:28 (NASB) *"The heart of the righteous ponders how to answer, But the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things."*

19. LIES

The foundation of the spirit of Jezebel proceeds from the "father of lies." Jesus tells the Jews who were Abraham's offspring, *"You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth because there is no truth in him. Whenever he tells a lie, he speaks from his own nature, because he is a liar and the father of lies."* John 8:44 (NASB)

In Jezebel's letter (with Ahab's seal) she convinced the people to get two false witnesses to testify that Naboth *"...cursed God and the king."* 1 Kings 21:10 (NASB) This never happened, **however if she could only deceive the people into believing it did, she knew they would kill him.** This accusation was an attack on both religion, because it was said that he cursed God, and government, because it was said that he cursed the king. Thus, Jezebel was targeting two major groups that govern the world. I hope you got that.

A Jezebel spirit can lie with confidence, boldness and persuasion, **making deception appear believable to those who do**

not yet recognize its tactics. It may use charm, emotional appeal, **or carefully chosen words to distort the truth and make what is false seem true.** Those who have already been wounded by this pattern often recognize the deception, while others may be persuaded by its appearance of sincerity.

20. TARGETS LEADERSHIP

It is a well-known fact that if you can control leadership, you can control the people. As we see with Jezebel, she married a leader and controlled through his authority. When she wanted to kill the man of God Naboth, she sent letters (under Ahab's seal) directed to the **"...elders and nobles who were living with Naboth in his city."** 1 Kings 21:8 (NASB)

If the body of Christ tolerates the spirit of Jezebel, the spirit of Jezebel will always control through the leadership. **Brothers and sisters, if you are in a fellowship that has not taught on the spirit of Jezebel, I urge you to pray that this ignorance, or silence, will not continue.** If you are moved by the Holy Spirit to approach the leadership about educating the people on it (and I do hope you are) PLEASE do not quench the Spirit of God in leading, you into all truth. A true body of believers will welcome such teaching. If a leadership is resistant in exposing the spirit of Jezebel, this could be proof that the congregation is being dominated by this spirit.

Here is a scripture to help you to discern for yourself.

"And if a kingdom is divided and rebelling against itself, that kingdom cannot stand. And if a house is divided (split into factions and rebelling) against itself, that house will not be able to last." Mark 3:24-25 (AMPC)

21. ENFORCES LOYALTY TO HER OWN LEADERSHIP

Part of the accusation against Naboth was that he cursed the king. There was no record that Naboth had ever done this. It is

important to remember that, while the appointed king was Ahab, they were ultimately under Jezebel's kingdom. In using his authority, she was enforcing to people the penalty of coming against her kingdom was death. We read in Kings that Jezebel was killing the true prophets. Why? It was because she could not "Lord" over them.

Child of God, though we should respect leaders, any leadership that demands us to be loyal or submitted to something other than God's spirit is demonic. Leaders born of God's spirit will have a nature like Paul who said, "Follow me as I follow Christ" instead of demanding loyalty no matter what.

Here are some scriptures to help you discern for yourself.

1 Peter 5:1-3 (AMPC) *"I warn and counsel the elders among you (the pastors and spiritual guides of the church) as a fellow elder and as an eyewitness [called to testify] of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a sharer in the glory (the honor and splendor) that is to be revealed (disclosed, unfolded): ² Tend (nurture, guard, guide, and fold) the flock of God that is [your responsibility], not by coercion or constraint, but willingly; not dishonorably motivated by the advantages and profits [belonging to the office], but eagerly and cheerfully; ³ Not domineering [as arrogant, dictatorial, and overbearing persons] over those in your charge, but being examples (patterns and models of Christian living) to the flock (the congregation)."*

22. ADVANCES AGENDAS THROUGH FASTING

As believers in the only true God, usually when we think of fasting, we think of God moving on our behalf in righteousness. However, in case you did not know, the powers of darkness are also persistent in fasting to advance the kingdom of darkness. When Jezebel wrote letters to the elders and leaders in Naboth's city, she encouraged them to ... *"Proclaim a fast, and seat Naboth at the head of the people."* Righteous Naboth was her target. This was not an act of

righteous fasting; rather, it was an act of an evil corporate fasting that ended in murder. (1 Kings 21:8-10)

23. AMBITIOUS TO VOLUNTEER AND WORK HARD

Just as Jezebel inserted herself into Ahab's situation with Naboth without being asked, the spirit of Jezebel often volunteers, **not from a pure desire to serve, but to gain influence and establish control**. Jezebel was eager to take on this whole situation, and she did it with such confidence and saying, *"I will give you the vineyard of Naboth the Jezreelite."* 1 Kings 21:7 (NASB)

She was very eager, energetic, and willing to work hard to write the letter with Ahab's seal, to get false witnesses, to come up with false accusations, and to address the nobles and elders in Naboth's community. However, beneath that outward willingness is a hidden agenda. The goal is not humble service, but access, control, and influence. Over time, the true motive will eventually be exposed.

24. SELF-SEEKING

This characteristic is closely connected to number 21. The Jezebel spirit is driven by dark, self-centered ambition. Its desires are not rooted in humility, service, or obedience to God, but in self-gain, self-promotion, and self-will. The attitude behind it is, "I want what I want, when I want it." This reveals a heart that worships its own will and demands its own way. A leader operating under this spirit will often speak in possessive terms, saying, "My vision is..." rather than, "We have a vision....," because the focus is not on the body of Christ or the will of God, but on personal control and personal recognition.

Here is a scripture to help you discern for yourself.

Remember the topic here in 1 Corinthians 13 is love. *"It is not conceited (arrogant and inflated with pride); it is not rude (unmannerly) and does not act unbecomingly. **Love (God's love in us) does not insist on its own rights or its own way, for it is not self-***

seeking; it is not touchy or fretful or resentful; it takes no account of the evil done to it [it pays no attention to a suffered wrong]." 1 Corinthians 13:5 (AMPC)

PRAYERS OF ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND REPENTANCE IN YOUR OWN LIFE

First, pray to the Father in Jesus' name and ask for Him to reveal to you if you have in fact been walking under the influence of the spirit of Jezebel. **It is so importance for you not to fall into condemnation if you have had a problem with a couple of these traits, because that does not necessarily mean you (or others) have the spirit of Jezebel.**

Now, if the Holy Spirit has revealed to you that you do have this spirit of Jezebel, here is a prayer to start with to help you:

Father, in Jesus' name, I acknowledge that I have yielded myself to the spirit of Jezebel. I confess and ask You to help me in a walk of true repentance. I come before You in humility, desiring Your standard of righteousness and holiness in my day-to-day life.

Please forgive me for tolerating this spirit of Jezebel, and being sympathetic to its ways, and opening myself to its influence in any way. Please forgive me and show me all of those whom I have hurt while being under this influence and help me to come clean and take responsibility for my actions in my ignorance.

Father, in moving forward, help me reject every pattern of thinking rooted in control, manipulation, or rebellion. I renounce the spirit of Jezebel and reject its influence in my life. In Jesus' name, I pull down this stronghold and submit myself fully to God, resisting the devil, and knowing he now must flee.

By the power of Holy Spirit, help me live according to Your righteousness, holiness, and truth. Open my eyes, expose any darkness by Your light, and teach me to walk in humility and obedience. Amen.

Now, some of you may have been raised up following the patterns of the spirit of Jezebel, therefore it is like unto getting free

from any addiction so it could be difficult. However, now, that you have said this prayer focus on practicing the principles of God's word and do them. As you continue to practice His word, your mind will be transformed, and it will get easier to walk uninfluenced by this spirit once and for all. By and through His word and His spirit lifelong possessions are broken off. Glory!

HOW TO ADDRESS THIS SPIRIT IN A CONGREGATIONAL SETTING

Now, first and foremost, the most important thing in dealing with a spirit of Jezebel in a congregational setting is going into corporate prayer and asking the Father, in Jesus' name, to reveal to the congregation corporately through His word and His Spirit if any spirits of Jezebel present. (Preferably after education, this spirit has been presented corporately and rightly divided.) If you do not all have this revelation then you will not be able to address this united in spirit, thus when this spirit fights back some of you will be double minded in your revelation and begin to tolerate Jezebel again. Remember this spirit is nothing to be afraid of, but it is very aggressive.

As the body of Christ studies the word of God together, the Holy Spirit will expose what needs to be exposed without gossip or striving (John 16:13). Remember when Jesus told His disciples that one of them would betray Him? He identified Judas by saying he was the one to whom He would give the sop. When Jesus' word was fulfilled, Judas was exposed. In the same way, once this spirit is exposed, it must be addressed according to the Word of God.

Once this spirit has been exposed everyone must understand what is being confronted, and that this is not a battle against flesh and blood. Therefore, any name-calling, gossip, and false accusations must not be tolerated. You must strive to keep the unity of the spirit in the bond of peace, while also not backing down to the enemy.

Ephesians 6:12 tells us our struggle is not against flesh and blood. In 2 Corinthians 10:3-4 we read that we do not war according to the flesh, for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh. So, how do we fight a spirit? You fight a spirit with the Holy Spirit and God's Word rightly divided.

PRAYERS IN A CONGREGATIONAL SETTING

Pray/declare all to the Father, in Jesus' name.

Please forgive us for tolerating this spirit of Jezebel in the body of Christ and thank you for revealing its presence.

We declare we have been given power and authority over serpent's scorpions and all powers of the enemy, and nothing at all can harm us. (Luke 10:19)

We cut off and reject all food from the table of Jezebel. (1 Kings 18:19)

We declare that there is not a weapon designed against us that shall thrive, and every tongue which increases against us in judgment we are condemning, for this is our inheritance as servants of the Lord! (Isaiah 54:17)

We declare great tribulation against Jezebel and her Kingdom (Revelation 2:22)

We prohibit all witchcraft resulting from any clairvoyant spirits including false prophecy that would attempt to corrupt the body of Christ.

We declare, we are of God, and we have already overcome every strategy of all antichrist spirits including Jezebel, because the power residing in us is far greater than any power of the antichrist. (1 John 4:4)

We give no place to the devil, and we overcome the spirit of Jezebel and receive power over all nations. (Ephesians 4:27; Revelation 2: 26)

We declare that manipulation any witchcraft of Jezebel in the body of Christ is null and void and we break any agendas of darkness that she has schemed in the body of Christ

We do have the mind of Christ and do hold the thoughts feelings and the purposes of his heart therefore we ask for your wisdom in Jesus' name in Identifying and dealing with the spirit of Jezebel.

(1 Corinthians 2:16)

Jezebel's attacks on the true body of Christ are null, void, and fruitless.

We declare we are hidden from the scourge of all tongues! Job 5:21

We declare the Lamb will destroy all enemies who make war with Him, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings! (Revelation 17:14)

We declare God is constantly increasing us and making us stronger than all our enemies including Jezebel. (Psalm 105:24)

We declare God has set us free from all bondages of corruption, and we have now entered this glorious freedom as children of God! (Romans 8:21)

We have a reverential fear of the Lord, and it is He who delivers me out of the hands of Jezebel! (2 Kings 17:39)

We are laying aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness through the spirit of Jezebel, and we are receiving with meekness God's implanted Word, which is saving our souls. (James 1:21)

CONCLUSION

I hope that you will pray about the information that has been presented in the word of God through this teaching. The primary goal here is to educate the present-day church about the spirit of Jezebel, in order that they would not be defeated. The book of Revelation is still unfolding, and we are living in its time. I also believe Jesus' warning to the church in Thyatira applies to the body of Christ today. Once we are taught about the present-day operation of this spirit and equipped with the necessary tools to discern and confront it, we are accountable to God's Word and must not tolerate it.
